Payment of fifty pounds to each of my Younger Children following to Wit
Elizabeth, Mary, Samuel, William and John, the said several Sums to be paid
my said son Joel at or before the expiration of five Years from the Death or Mar-
riage of my said Wife, and I do hereby give and Bequeath the said several Sums of fifty
to each of my Younger Children aforesaid and expressly charge and Burthen the
above Moiety devised to my son Joel with the Payment thereof

I do hereby order and direct that my Lands in Passapatanz Neck in Cecil County
whereon I lately lived, shall be sold by my Executors in Fee Simple, within One year
after my decease, three Months public Notice being first give of the time and place
of such Sale, and that the Money arising from the said Sale be applied to the Discharge
of the debts I owe to Thomas Jones, James Morgan and Samuel Chew. And should
it so happen, that the said Lands will not sell for as much as will pay the whole of the
said Debts, then I order and direct that whatever it shall sell for be paid to the said
Thomas Jones, James Morgan and Samuel Chew in proportion to their several Demands
against me. but should it so happen that the said Lands should sell for more than will
discharge the said debts, then I order and direct that the Overplus shall be considered
as part of my personal Estate.

I will and direct that whatever Money
shall be owing to me at the time of my Death, by my son David shall be considered
as part of my personal Estate. The Residue of my Estate I give and devise to
all my Children viz. David, Joel, Ann, Elizabeth, Mary, Samuel, William
and John, to be equally divided between them. I constitute and appoint my dear

Wife sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Affixed my Seal this third day of May, in the year of our
