 State of Maryland, being of sound and Disposing mind and Memory, do
 make this my last will and testament in manner following to Wit.

 to the Land of Mr. Beal Bordley then with the line of the said Mr. Bordley until it
 intersects the Main road called the Tarley road, then with the said road to the Gate
 then with the said road to the Gate where it meets the road going from my House to
 Saint Pauls Parish Church then with the said Road to the Beginning

2^{dly} I give to my Son William Wilmer two seats in a pew in the new part of Saint Pauls
 Parish Church, and my part of the stills

3^{dly} I give to my Daughter Mary Wilmer my Negro Man Sam, and one feather
 Bed and furniture.

4^{thly} I give to my Daughter Margaret Wilmer my
 Negro Man Stark, and my Negro Girl Hannah, and one feather Bed and furniture.

5^{thly} I give to my Daughter Frances Wilmer my Negro Woman Ann, and her Increase,
 my Negro Boy Sam, and one feather Bed and furniture.

6^{thly} I give my Negro Woman Jane to my two Daughters Margaret Wilmer, and
 Frances Wilmer

7^{thly} I give my three Daughters Mary, Margaret, and
 Frances, my Clock and all my silver spoons.

8^{thly} I give my Wearing apparel
 to be divided between my four Daughters Mary, Margaret, Frances, and Martha.

9^{thly} After all my Just debts are paid I give all the remaining part of my estate to my
 Daughters Mary Wilmer, Margaret Wilmer, Frances Wilmer, and Martha Bond, to be
 Equally divided between them.

Lastly My Will is that my Estate be taken
 into possession by those to whom I have given it by this Will. Immediately after my
 Death without any Administration on my Estate, and I request my sons in Law
 William Ringgold, James Trisby and Richard Miller to see, that this my Will
