

In the Name of God Amen George Hastings being of sound and disposing Mind and Memory, do make this my last will and testament in Manner following - First I do hereby empower and direct my Executors herein Named to pay all my Just debts out of my Estate before there is a Disposition made of any part or Parcel thereof and to pay those debts in Kent County which I am sued for before any others in case I should be Obliged by Law to pay the same. Secondly I give to my Sister Mary Yardsley fifty five pounds which sum she is owing me. and Thirdly I give to my Nephew George Hastings all the remainder of my Estate both real and personal to him the said George Hastings his Heirs and Assigns forever. and Fourthly I do Nominate Constitute and appoint George Hastings my Nephew, and Thomas McClure Executors of this my last will and testament revoking all other wills by me heretofore made. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Fifth day of April 1790.

August 9th 1790. then came Geo. Hastings, and made Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that the within Instrument of writing is the true and whole will and testament of George Hastings late of K^t County deced, that hath come to his hands or possession, and that he doth not know of any other - before Wm Nicholson Reg: Mills for K^t County.

State of Maryland Aug: 9th 1790. then came William Howell, Saml Roberts and W^t County to Wit. Wm Tilden Son of Wm B Tilden the three subscribing Witnesses to the foregoing last will and testament of Geo. Hastings late of Kent County deced, and made Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God, that they did see the testator herein Named, sign and seal this will and that they heard him publish pronounce and Declare the same to be his last will and testament, that at the time of his so doing he was to the best of their Apprehensions of sound and disposing mind Memory and understanding, and that they subscribed their respective Names as witnesses to this will in the presence and at the request of the testator and in the presence of each other - before Wm Nicholson Reg: Mills for K^t County.
