I Daniel Cunningham of Kent County in the State of Maryland being sick and weak of body but of sound mind & Memory thanks be given to God for the same and calling to mind the uncertainty of this transitory life do make publish & Declare this my last Will & testament in Manner and form following (to wit) first I Give and bequeath to my brother in law Matthew Dyer my Doler and wearing Apparat & last I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Ann Cunningham all the remainder part of my Estate after paying my debts funeral Expences & Charges administration to her & her disposal also I do nominate and appoint my said wife Ann Cunningham My Executrix of this my last Will & Testament Revoking all other Will or Wills by me heretofore made in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twenty ninth day of June in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety 1790
