 Calm all day at 4.30 p.m. light  
 breeze from SE all sail set clear weather  
 Employed on ship duty pump and light  
 Carefull attended no obs. end day

April Saturday 3  
 Fresh breeze from SE and clear weather  
 the employed on ship duty pump and  
 Light Carefull attended  
 lat- 24° 16' long 61° 52' end day

April Sunday 4  
 Strong breeze from S and high sea  
 the ~~ship~~ on the trysail very cloudy  
 weather this morning saw vessel bound

April Friday 9  
 Strong breeze from Easterly cloudy weather  
 and squally rain all day we expect  
 to see island Sombrew today but weather  
 was so cloud cant see we heave to on  
 starboard employed on ship duty pump  
 and light Carefull attended no obs.  
 saw bark L.M. end the day

 Strong breeze from NE cloudy

 island of west-indian aregada island  
 at 7.30 a.m. we lay on trysail and
