The ship heave up anchor from dominica
at 11 am. bound to St Eustatius
the ~~by~~ the hants and brigam Viola
left dominica 7 hour before this bound
to St Eustatius employed ship duty pump
and light-carefull attended
and when ~~we~~ were making sail heave
up anchor we get collision with
gay hound but no damage get out clear
end day

May 1 Saturday 1915
light breeze from N. clear weather ship by
Montserrat and brigam Viola in sight
Employed on ship duty pump and light
carefully attended
end day

May 2 Sunday
Light breeze from N.E. clear weather
Ship drop anchor at St Eustatius 12 am
and Viola drop is anchor at same time

Carefull attended end day

May 3 Monday
light breeze from N.E. clear weather
bark wander anchor at 8 p.m. last night
and schooner D. Nickerson anchor at 2 p.m.

end day
