The employed on ship duty Capt. fined  
Repeating stern boat the watch paulling  
stern boat nothing saw pump and light  
Carefull attended  
Lat 26° 02' N. long 63° 02 1/2' W.  
end of day

May Wednesday the 12<sup>th</sup> 1915  
Light breeze from E. wind clear weather  
The employed on ship duty pump and  
light Carefull attended the watch up  
Master head nothing saw Lat 27° 16' N.  
Long 62° 58' W.  
end the day

May Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> the 1915  
Light breeze from S.W. wind clear weather  
The employed on ship duty the man  
up Master head nothing saw pump and  
light Carefull attended  
Lat 29° 00' N. long 62° 14' W.  
end day
