Throughout this day light breeze and clear
Weather wind from westerly ship on
small sail close hauled employed on
ship duty boiling and stored down
oil. Jaine Costa fell better pump
carefully attended W.O.S. end of this day

May

Wednesday the 26 the 1915

Throughout this day beginning with
light breeze and clear weather the wind
from westerly at p.m. squally with
light rain. Employed on ship
duty the watch finished & pulled out oil
and stored down 94 barrel oil
the pump carefully attended
lat 32° 53' N long 54° 13' W.
end of this day

Thursday the 27 1915

Throughout this day light breeze and
clear weather wind from S.W. ship
lay on small sail employed on ship
duty pump carefully attended
lat 32° 30' N long 54° 14' W.
end of this day

May

Friday 28 1915

Throughout this day beginning with squally
Weather and light rain at p.m. calm
employed on ship duty pump carefully
attended lat 32° 35' N long 58° 31' W.
end of this day

May

Saturday the 29 1915

Throughout this day calm and squally
with rain wind from westerly
employed on ship duty pump carefully
attended the watch up on lookout
nothing saw but hail in sight
Bound Easterly W.O.S. end of this day

May

Sunday the 30 1915

Throughout this day fresh breeze and
kind hazy weather the wind from S.W.
employed on ship duty watch up on
lookout nothing saw ship lay on starboard
tack on small sail Jaine Costa fell better
come back to is duty lat 33° 17' N.
Long 52° 10' W.
end of this day

May

Monday the 31 1915

Throughout this day fresh breeze
and hazy weather wind from westerly
ship lay on starboard tack with
small sail employed on ship duty
pump carefully attended watch on
lookout nothing saw lat 33° 41' N
Long 51° 29' W.
end of this day
