June the 15 1915-

high sea wind from westerly the
Watch employed boiler out and stowed
down oil pump carefully attended
Lat 34° 13' N.
Long. 46° 04' W. end of day

Wednesday
June the 16 1915-

Throughout this day fresh breeze and clear
Weather wind from N. and high sea
Watch employed finish stowed down
oil 80 barrel and 25 gallon Lat 33° 44' N.
Long. 47° 26' W. end of this day

June the 17 1915-

Clear weather and high sea wind from
North employed on ship duty Capt. Rap. coing
