Throughout this day beginning with light breeze and squally with rain wind from S.W. watch employed on ship duty at 8.30 a.m. mate rise school whales low down three mate get two second mate get one third mate struck one take all line came board get ready cutting out send gears down low steam bound W. no obs. end of this day.

Throughout this day beginning with calm at p.m. light breeze and squally with rain watch employed tryn hout oil low two steam one bound East one west wind from north Sydney Victor back to is. duty and James Costa back to is duty lat 33° 04' N.

S.B.V. Throughout this day light breeze and fine weather wind from south all sail set at 9.40 a.m. mate low school big whales low down three boat second mate get one bring board star cutting the head live long light hobs end of this day

July
Saturday the 10 1915-

Throughout this day light breeze and cloudy weather wind from S.E. ship under small sail watch employed finish cutting whale send down gears star tryn hout lat 32° 50' N.
Long 44° 09' W. end of this day

July
Sunday the 11 1915-

L.B.V. Throughout this day light breeze and fine clear weather wind from S.E. watch employed tryn hout and at 5.40 a.m. John Rocha low school whales low down two boat mate get one second mate struck one ~~but~~ the line came board cutting. send down gears lat 33° 05' N.
