East lat 33° 28' N. Long. 44° 25' W
end of this day

July
Wednesday the 14 1915

Throughout this day light breeze and
Clear weather wind from S. all sail set
Watch employed on ship duty saw
Barely bound Easterly lat 33° 32' N.
Long 45° 00' W.
end of this day

July
Thursday the 15 1915

Throughout this day light breeze and
Clear weather wind from S.W. all sail
set Employed on ship duty. Saw Gramp
and pupos and saw six waterhoores
Bound Easterly lat 33° 30' N.
Long. 44° 33' 1/2 W.
end of this day

July
Friday the 16 1915

Throughout this day fresh breeze and
Clear weather wind from S.W. all sail set
at p.m. short down on trysail
Watch employed on ship duty saw nothing
but Gramp the pump Carefull attended.
Lat 33° 32' N.
Long. 45° 52' 1/2 W. end of the day

July
Saturday the 17 1915

Throughout this day beginning with strong
breeze and squally with rain at p.m.
Moderate some wind S.W. ship on small
sail Watch employed on ship duty saw
nothing but black fish lat 33° 27' N.
Long. pump Carefull attended end day

July
Sunday the 18 1915

Throughout this day beginning with squally
with rain at 10 a.m. steady breeze and
Clear weather wind from S. all sail set
Watch employed on ship duty saw
nothing lat 33° 06' N.
Long. 45° 34' 1/4 W. end of this day

July
Monday the 19 1915

Throughout this day steady breeze and
fine weather wind from S.E. all sail
set at p.m. short down to trysail
Watch employed on ship duty saw
nothing but pupos ^{steam} lat 33° 18' N.
Long. 46° 41' W.
end of this day
