

August Remarks on board of schooner C.E. Whelan
Thursday the 5 1915

This day fresh breeze and cloudy weather
wind from north all sail set but fig top
and main top sail in employed on ship duty
saw nothing but steam bound to west
pump carefully attended lat 31° 46' N.
Long. 59° 55' W.
end of this day

August
Friday the 6 1915

Throughout this day steady breeze and
clear weather wind from N.W. all sail
set close should watch employed on ship duty
mate saw a larger whale at 5:30 p.m. low down
toward boat but not get it was going to
windward fast pump carefully attended
Lat 31° 38' N.
Long. 61° 28' W. end of this day

August
Saturday the 7 1915

Throughout this day steady breeze and
clear weather wind from north all sail
set close should watch employed on ship
duty saw sail vessel bound to south
Lat 31° 15' N.
Long 63° 03' W. end of this day

August
Sunday the 8 the 1915

This day calm and clear weather watch
employed on ship duty at 11:45 a.m.
Charles Alves saw larger whale low
down three boat third mate went on him
he saw the boat not get it lat 31° 29' N.
Long. 63° 59' W. end

Monday the 9 1915

Throughout this beginning with light
breeze from S.E. clear weather at p.m.
Calm watch employed on ship duty
saw nothing but steam bound to
Easterly lat 31° 32' N. Long 64° 24' W.
end of this day

August
Tuesday the 10 1915

Throughout this day light breeze and
clear weather wind from S.W. all sail
set at 10:30 a.m. we sighted with island
of Bermuda S.W. of it about 20 miles
and at 4:35 John Rocha saw larger
whale in shore low down toward boat not get it
was going to windward fast saw steam bound in
lat 32° 05' N.
Long. 64° 55' W. end of this day

August
Wednesday the 11 1915

Throughout this day beginning with squally
with rain wind from westerly watch
employed on ship duty at 2:40 p.m. Charles
Alves saw larger whale low toward boat
second mate get it came at 10:30 p.m.
lat 32° 16' N.
Long. 65° 24' W. end of this day

August
Thursday the 12 1915

Throughout this day light breeze and clear
weather wind from N. watch employed
cutting the whale and star try out the skin
cutting the whale the pendent burst we have
to fix somehow to finish cutting
Lat 32° 13' N Long. 65° 03' W end day
