Thursday September 20th - 66

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we had all sail set & one sail in sight & our men have been employed cleaning up our decks & other things &c. Middle part pleasant with a light breeze & we were under short sail & we hauled a little. Loatter part pleasant with a light breeze & we had all sail set & several sails in sight. They are all merchant vessels & we spoke one & a sprail schooner & we sent letters. She was bound to Halifax from London &c

Friday Sept 21st - 66

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we had all sail set & steering for the S. & several sails in sight all of them are merchant vessels & at 6 P.M. we shortened sail & hauled back. Middle part pleasant with a light breeze. Loatter part pleasant with a light breeze & we made all sail & kept the ship off S. & for Hyaral & all hands on deck employed at coppering our sail & washing ship &c

Saturday Sept 22nd - 66

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we had all sail set & steering for Hyaral & all hands on deck worked & coppering our sail & washing ship & at 4 P.M. we raised & land it was flying & we were at 7 P.M. we hauled the light sails & kept our ship per Carre &c. Middle part strong winds & we were under easy sail & at 10 P.M. we hauled back & let her lay till morning.
