Friday October 19-00

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & our men have been employed at rattring down our rigging from latitude was today about 1840. The middle part pleasant with a light breeze & we had all sail set & about one o'clock we luffed to & heeled back for fear of getting to close to the shore of the Cape de Verd. Latter part land close to & we went into St. Nicholas & there we stayed 24 hours to let one of our Boatmen go to see his folks & was done some rattring &c

Saturday October 20-00

The first part of the 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we was lying off to an St. Nicholas &c Middle part the same & Latter part the same St. Nicholas

Sunday October 21-00

The first part of these 24 hours of berant with a light breeze & we were still lying off to an St. Nicholas Middle part we left the St. Nicholas & are now bound for the Tristan a round. Latter part pleasant with a light breeze right off & we are going about South

Monday October 22-00

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we are at the Cape de Verd. There is a light Middle part pleasant with a light breeze & that was happening. Latter part pleasant with a light breeze & our men have been employed at rattring down our topmast rigging & picking over oranges & pulling them in nets. & rattring our Studding sail boom &c

off we have the Cape de Verd & are bound for Tristan

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we have all sail set & are now bound for Tristan. Our men have been employed at rattring down our topmast rigging &c Middle part pleasant with a light breeze. Latter part pleasant with a light breeze & we have all sail set & steering S. with a fair wind for Tristan latitude. Our men have been employed at rattring down our topmast rigging.

Wednesday October 24-00

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we have all sail set & steering S. for Tristan. Our men have been employed at rattring down our topmast rigging & rattring down our back stays &c Middle part very good weather, we had one rain squall. Latter part pleasant with a very light air & our men have been employed at rattring down our rigging &c

Thursday October 25-00

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we raised peak first & we toward to catch three four men have been employed at rattring down the middle part some squally with rain &c. Latter part we had a light breeze & some rain squalls & one merchant vessel in sight & our men have been employed at rattring down & trying out our black fish &c

Friday October 26-00

The first part of these 24 hours very good weather & our men have been employed at rattring down our rigging &c Middle part very good weather. Latter part very good weather only a little rain & one brig in sight & our men have been employed at rattring down our rigging & breaking out for our flap cables &c
