Wednesday January 7th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours blowing strong from Hand, all sail filled but our main top sail & that we close reefed & histed up our boats on the upper cranes & C Middle part - blowing strong & C Scatter part - strong winds & we made a little more sail & at 7 P.M. we raised 2 right whales. & we toward three boats but did strike & C

Wednesday January 7th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours good weather & we raised 3 boats & one whale but did not strike & at 7 P.M. we shortened sail. & C Middle part good weather with a fresh breeze & C Scatter part - the same & we raised 2 right whales & we toward 3 boats & did not give any & they went off to the leeward & C

Thursday January 8th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we have been making all day & could not get any & C Middle part - fresh breeze from the N.E. & C Scatter part - blowing a fair & we had all sail filled but our main top sail & that we close reefed & C

Friday Jan 9th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours blowing a gale & we had all sail filled but our main top sail & that we close reefed & we had our boats histed up on our upper cranes & at 4 P.M. it began to moderate & C Middle part - good weather & we were under short sail & C Scatter part - the same only we made a little more sail & C

Saturday January 10th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours very good weather & we were under very sail & C Middle part - good weather & our ship was under short sail & C Scatter part - fresh breeze & we were under very sail & we were mending our fore sail. we had all hands on deck toward night & C

Sunday Jan 11th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes & we were under very sail & we were mending our fore sail & we finished at 4 P.M. & then we went at 10 at 7 P.M. we shortened sail & we close reefed & C Middle part - strong winds & C Scatter part - the same & we were under very sail & C

Monday January 12th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds & we were under very sail all day & C Middle part - strong winds from the S.W. & C Scatter part - the same

Tuesday Jan 13th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds & some rain & C Middle part - rain & C Scatter part - fair weather & at 10 A.M. we raised 2 right whales & we toward all of our boats & we strike and & C

Wednesday January 14th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant with a light breeze & we have been pulling after first mate all day nearly he was part of a right whale & the whale ran away with him & he cut line & came on board & at 7 P.M. we shortened sail & set the watches & C Middle part - pleasant & calm & C Scatter part - breeze up & looked like a storm & we made all sail & C

Thursday January 15th 1807

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds & some squally with rain & we shortened sail & C Middle part - good weather with a fresh breeze & C Scatter part - good weather with a pleasant breeze & at about 6 o'clock A.M. we raised two right whales & we toward 3 boats & chased them a while & then gallied them & then we called the boats along side & they toward them a while & then we sent them off after them a gain but we could not catch them & C
