Tuesday May 21. 1867

The first part of these 24 hours fresh breezes to our
leeward watch were in liberty & 4 of them run away to
Middle part blowing strong & C
Leeward part the same & we took a raft on shore and
party filled that & it was raining all day & C

Wednesday May 22

The first part rainy & blowing & we were employed at
at ships duties & C
Middle part good weather & C & C
Leeward part pleasant & we were employed at ships
duties some chop as stowing down water & getting off water

Thursday May 23

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we were employed
at ships duties. Some stowing down water & wood, and we
took over run aways on board again & put them all in iron
& put fish down in the run & the other three we put in the
Sail then Middle part good weather & C
Leeward part the same & we were employed at washing
Ship and side & getting ready for painting & C

Friday May 24

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we were
employed at ships duties & C
Middle part pleasant & C
Leeward part the same & we were employed at washing
Ship and side & getting ready for painting & C

Saturday May 25

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we were employed
at washing Ship outside & getting ready for painting & C
Middle part pleasant & C
Leeward part Sprally & rainy & we were employed at putting
in new bloods in our lower rigging & replying and moin
Tusail yard aft in three bands & our first mate took a boat
and went up the river, & C & our captain came off & sent in
a boat after the american consail & doctor & they stayed
off all day & drank more whiskey than a little & C

Sunday May 26. 1867

The first part of these 24 hours rainy & our captain
was off & he had company the american consail & doctor
and meal times they eat by them selves, and that is mean & C
Middle part rainy & C
Leeward part it cleared off & became fine weather & C

Monday May 27

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & C
Middle part the same. & we had 5 ladies visitors on
board & C
Leeward part pleasant & we were employed at getting our
potatoes on board & C painting Ship

Tuesday May 28

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we were employed
at painting Ship & C
Middle part good weather
Leeward part the same & we were employed at painting
Ship & fixing our rigging & C

Wednesday May 29

The first part of these 24 hours some Sprally & we were employed
at painting Ship & C when it cleared off & C
Middle part good weather & C
Leeward part good weather & we were employed at ships
duties & C

Thursday May 30

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we were employed
at ships duties & C
Middle part pleasant & C
Leeward part the same & not much doing on board & C

Friday May 31. 1867

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & about 4 P.M.
we got under way and dropped our anchor out side of the
heads. Middle part pleasant & C
Leeward the same & our mate went off fishing & C
