Monday October 12-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we had all sail set & steering N.E. by N. with a light breeze from the N.W. & at 6 P.M. we shortened sail & luffed to the wind with our heads yards aback &c.
Middle part pleasant & we were under short sail & luffing with our heads yards aback &c.
 Latter part pleasant & we made all sail & our men have been employed at stowing down our sail & we finished about 12 M. & we cleaned up some of our things &c.

Tuesday October 13-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we had all sail set & our men have been employed at washing ship in side &c. at 6 P.M. we shortened sail
Middle part pleasant & we were under short sail
 Latter part pleasant & we made all sail & we raised a sail & we jammed her. I was the Ellen &c.

Wednesday October 14-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we had all sail set & we were jamming with the Ellen & at 6 P.M. we shortened sail &c.
Middle part pleasant & we were under short sail
 Latter part pleasant & we made sail & the Ellen were in sight

Thursday October 15-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we had all sail set & we are going to jam again with the Ellen & at 4 P.M. we jammed &c.
 & we raised, popped or some other kind of pop & we took them to be sperm whales & being late we could not make sure &c. &c. &c.
Middle part pleasant & we were jamming with the Ellen & we layed aback all night &c.
 Latter part pleasant & we made sail & we steered to the south & the Ellen to same

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Friday October 16-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we had about all sail set & steering to the south with the wind from the N.E. & the Ellen the same & at 6 P.M. we shortened sail &c.
Middle part pleasant & we were under short sail
 Latter part pleasant & we made sail & we steered south with the wind from the north & the Ellen the same &c. about calm

Saturday October 17-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & about calm & we & the Ellen were steering south with the wind from the north & at 6 P.M. we shortened sail
Middle part pleasant & we were under short sail
 Latter part pleasant & we made sail in company with the Ellen & we jammed about all day with her & our men were employed at ship's duties such as fixing our cutting blocks &c.

Sunday October 18-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we were jamming with the Ellen until 11 P.M.
Middle part pleasant & about calm
 Latter part pleasant & about calm & we sighted the Northern light coming towards us

Monday October 19-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & the Ellen & Northern light were in sight & at 6 P.M. we jammed the Ellen & shortened sail
Middle part pleasant & about calm &c. &c.
 Latter part pleasant & we made all sail & the Emma Jones & Ellen & Northern light were in sight &c.

Tuesday October 20-1868

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we had all sail set & about 2 P.M. we jammed the Emma Jones & Northern light & at 6 P.M. we shortened sail &c. &c. - looked like a storm &c.
