Thursday October 22-1868

The first part of these 24 hours quite good weather
& about 2 P.M. we jammed with the Northern
light & Emma C. until about 1 P.M.

Middle part good weather we were under
short sail in sight of the other 2 ships
Scatter part quite good weather we
made sail in company with the Emma C.
& Northern light

Friday October 23-1868

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze
& the Northern light & Emma C. Jones were
in sight to 4 P.M. we shortened sail

Middle part strong breeze we were under short sail
Scatter part strong breeze we made sail to the
Northern light the same & Emma C. the same
we raised the gasnold & she came down to us

Saturday October 24-1868

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze we
were jamming with the Emma C. Jones & gasnold
to 4 P.M. we shortened sail to the
Middle part strong breeze we were under short sail
Scatter part quite good weather we were jamming with the
gasnold & Emma C. Jones all day

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Sunday October 25-1868

The first part of these 24 hours quite fair weather
& we were jamming all day with the gasnold
& Emma C. Jones to 6 P.M. we shortened sail
Middle part strong breeze we were under short sail to
Scatter part about the same we made sail to the
Gasnold & Emma C. Jones were in sight to

Monday October 26-1868

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze
we were under easy sail part of the time to the gasnold
& Emma C. Jones were in sight & we raised 2 main
blocks & we set our signal & board 3 boats but we
did not get any to 7 P.M. we shortened sail to
Middle part strong breeze we were under short sail
Scatter part strong breeze we were under double reef
topsails to 4 P.M. the gasnold & Emma C. Jones
were in sight to and men have been employed at
ships duties to
