The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the Eastward we were steering to the Westward in company with the *Garnold* & Co at 6 P.M. we shortened sail & the *Garnold* came down & spoke at the Middle part strong breezes from the Eastward under short sail. Latter part good weather & we jammed with the *Garnold* all day & Co

Sunday November 15-1808

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the East we were steering to the Westward under double reef topsails & the *Garnold* was the same & we were jamming with the *Garnold* until 7 P.M. & Co Middle part strong breezes & we were under short sail Latter part the same only it was some thick & hazy & we were steering to the Westward in company with the *Garnold* & Co. & Co

Monday November 16-1808

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the North & we were under double reef topsails & steering to the Westward in company with the *Garnold* & Co & Co at 6 P.M. we luffed to the third & shortened sail & Co Middle part strong breezes & we were under short sail Latter part was rainy & thick & we were under short sail & Co

Tuesday November 17-1808

The first part of these 24 hours calm & rainy & Co *Garnold* was still low & we made some sail & at 6 P.M. we shortened sail & Co Middle part strong breezes from the South & Co Latter part good weather & we made all sail & headed to the Westward by the wind on the Port tack & the *Garnold* was the same & our men have been employed at ship's duties & Co. & Co

Wednesday November 18-1808

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the South & we were on the Port tack by the wind & heading about N. E. bound to Norfolk Island & Co *Garnold* the same & Co. P.M. shortened sail Middle part strong breezes from the South & we were under short sail & heading to the Westward Latter part the same only we made some more sail & our men have been employed at ship's duties & Co in company with the *Garnold* & Co. & Co

Thursday November 19-1808

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the South & we were on the Port tack & by the wind heading about N. E. *Garnold* the same & bound for Norfolk Island & Co. P.M. we shortened sail & Co Middle part pleasant & we were under short sail Latter part pleasant & we made all sail & steered S. W. with the wind from the E. & Co in company with the *Garnold* & Co. & Co

Friday November 20-1808

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we had all sail set & steering S. W. in company with the *Garnold* & Co. P.M. we shortened sail & Co Middle part pleasant & calm & we were under short sail Latter part pleasant & we made all sail & steered by the wind on the Starboard tack heading about N. E. W. & the *Garnold* the same & Co

Saturday November 21-1808

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we had all sail set & steering by the wind on the Starboard tack heading about N. E. W. & Co *Garnold* the same & Co. P.M. we jammed with the *Garnold* & Co Middle part pleasant & we were under short sail & Co Latter part pleasant & we made all sail & steered by the wind on the Starboard tack heading about S. W. in company with the *Garnold* & Co. & Co
