our men were employed at mending our old masted

Friday May 22 - 1869

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we  
were under all sail & trying to steer S.W. for  
Manganni &c  
middle part good weather & we had all sail set &  
steering S.W. by the compass with the wind from  
latter part the same & our men have been employed  
at ship duties &c

Saturday May 23 - 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds  
& we were under all sail & the  
middle part part of the time strong winds from  
the north & we were under all sail & the  
latter part light winds & thick & rainy weather & we  
were still lying with our head yards aback waiting  
for it to clear up so we could go into land &c
