Sunday June 20th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours blowing a

close reef maintop sail & about 3 P. M. we
thipped a heavy sea &c
Middle part it blowed our four topmast staysails
away & it blowed heavy for a while & rained very
hard Latter part about the same &c &c

Monday June 21st 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze &
squalls with rain until 3 P. M. then we had a good
squall & then it cleared off & we had good weather &c
Middle part Strong breeze & we were under short
Latter part the same but we made a little more
sail & one man have been employed at ship's
duties

Tuesday June 22nd 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds
from the S. by the more were under double reef top sail
Middle part the same & we were under short sail &c
Latter part Strong winds & squalls & we made
a little more sail & our men employed at ship's
duties

Wednesday June 23rd 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds
& squalls & we were under double reef top sail & we
had a P. M. we headed our foretop sail & hoisted 20.10
Middle part Strong winds & squalls &c
Latter part the same & we made some more sail
& we went down our four top sail & went to mending
it

Thursday June 24th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds
& one man have been employed at mending our
foretop sail &c

Friday June 25th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours good weather &
we were on the Port tack by the wind heading
show S. by S. at 6 P. M. we shortened sail & sail
Middle part Strong winds & we were under short
Latter part we made a little more sail but not
much being that there is a strong wind &c &c

Saturday June 26th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds
& we were under close reef maintop sail
Middle part Strong winds & we were under short sail
Latter part the same but we made some more sail & our
men have been employed at mending our all present &c

Sunday June 27th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds &
our men were employed a part of these time in heading
our fore sail &c &c weather coming better &c
Middle part Strong winds & we were under short
Latter part the same but we made a little more
sail &c

Monday June 28th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds
& we were under double reef top sail & hoisted 20.10
Middle part Strong winds & we were under short sail
Latter part Strong winds & we made some more sail
& our men were employed at mending our maintop
sail & had S. A. M. as shifted the top line
Emma C forest & coming &c

Tuesday June 29th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours good weather & we
spoke the Emma C forest & top line &c &c
carried away our flying jib & stay & had to splice
