The first part of these 24 hours pleasant & we were under all sail & trying to get to the Westward & C. D. & we were shortened our light sail & C. D. Middle part pleasant & we were under topsails & C. D. & latter part good weather & we made all sail & we are bound for *Manzanilla* & our men have been employed at ships duties

Tuesday July 6th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds & squally & we are trying to get to *Manzanilla* but we have a N. E. wind & we don't make progress & C. D. & we are shortened sail & Middle part strong winds & we were under topsails & C. D. & we are bound for *Manzanilla* & about 3. A. M. we carried away our mainmast & fell & C. D.

Wednesday July 7th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong winds & some squally & we were under short sail & our men have been employed at mending our mainmast & C. D. Middle part good weather & we were under short sail & latter part pleasant & we were under all sail by the wind on the Starboard tack & about 10. A. M. we sighted *St. John* & we were going to the windward & we board all 4 boats & we gallied & missed them & at night we struck and drifted & until 1 a clock in the evening & then our iron screw was broken & we were holding on to him all night
