 & on the Port tack by the wind heading about N. W.
 Latter part good weather & we made all sail &
 Steered to the N. & then to the E. & S. & C.

Monday September 13th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze
 & we had all sail set & steering E. with the wind
 from the S. & P. M. we were ship & headed
 the W. & then we shortened sail & C.
 Middle part good weather & we were under short sail
 Latter part good weather & we made sail & our
 men have been employed at stowing down our
 sail & steering N. E. with the wind from the W.

Tuesday September 14th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze from
 the W. & we were steering to the N. E. & our men were
 employed at stowing down our sail & P. M. we shortened
 Middle part good weather & we were under short sail
 & steering W. with the wind from the South & S.
 Latter part the same only we made about 1/2
 had all hand on deck until 10. A. M. to wash off
 our decks

Wednesday September 15th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours good weather &
 with the wind from the E. & we were up the
 W. on the Port tack & P. M. we shortened sail
 Middle part good weather & we were under short
 sail Latter part good weather & we had all hands
 on deck employed at breaking out for our sail &
 in the fore hole to find out where it leaks
 & stowing it back again & P. M. & C.

The first part of these 24 hours good weather & we
 had all hands on deck employed at breaking out

 Middle part good weather & we were under short sail
 Latter part good weather & we made sail & returned
 by the wind on the Port tack by the wind

Friday September 17th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours good weather with
 the wind from the E. & we were on the Port tack
 by the wind N. E. P. M. we were ship & shortened
 sail & C. Middle part good weather & we were under
 Latter part strong breeze from the E. & we
 were on the Port tack by the wind & our
 men have been employed at ships duties

Saturday September 18th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze
 from the E. & we were on the Port tack by the
 wind N. E. P. M. we shortened sail & C.
 Middle part strong breeze from the E. & we
 were under short sail by the wind on the Port
 Latter part strong breeze from the E. & we were
 under easy sail & our men were employed at
 ships duties & mending our old spars & C.

Sunday September 19th 1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong wind
 from the E. & we were under easy sail by the
 wind on the Port tack & P. M. we were
 ship & shortened sail & heading about N. W.
 Middle part strong breeze from the E. & we
 Latter part strong breeze from the E. & we
 were on the Starboard tack by the wind
 heading about N. E. & P. M. we saw a
 Break about 3 miles off & did not see it
 again & C. & C.
