

27 *Beard's Fork* *Wm. Barker* *off land* *2 hours*

Saturday November 27-1869

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant breeze had all sail set & steering to the Eastward & examining with the coral reef saw some grass & coral & at 7 P.M. we shortened sail & the middle part strong breeze from the N.W. & we were under short sail & steering N.E. for Norfolk Island. Latter part the same breeze made full sail & steering by the wind heading about E. on the Port tack. The coral was in sight but she went off on the starboard tack. 7 P.M. H.A. No we had all sail furled excepting the main top sail & that was clewed up.

Sunday November 28-1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the W. & we were under short sail & steering N.E. by E. Middle part good weather & we were under easy sail & steering N.E. by E. with the wind from the W. & the latter part pleasant breeze made all sail & steering N.E. with the wind from the W.

Monday November 29-1869

The first part of these 24 hours pleasant breeze more under all sail & steering N.E. with the wind from the W. & beyond for Norfolk Island. Middle part light wind & calm & we were under all sail & steering N.E. & we bound for Norfolk & the latter part strong wind from the N. & we had all sail set & steering by the wind on the Port tack heading about E. & E. & our men were employed at ship & food.

Tuesday November 30-1869

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the N. & we were cracking it to her trying to get to Norfolk but we have a head wind & we are on the Port tack by the wind heading about E. & E. & we are in N.E. Middle part strong breeze & especially 3 P.M. we were under double reefed sails & steering by the wind heading N.E. & the Port tack bound for Norfolk. Latter part it cleared & became good weather & we were under all sail & steering by the wind from the W. & we were in N.E.
