

Ship Cambria from A Cruise Towards the Sandwich ^{Islands}

Friday August 11th 1843
All these 24 hours brisk trades from N to N.E. steering N.W. and N.W. by W so ends Lat by Obs. 15° 17' N Long by Obs. 144° 50'

Saturday August 12th 1843
All these 24 hours brisk trades with fair weather steering N.W. with all sail set so ends Lat by Obs. 16° 36' Long by Obs. 147° 15'

Sunday August 13th 1843 Commences with a brisk trade with pleasant weather steering N.W. with all sail set middle part steering N.W. half past 7 A.M. saw a large whale at 9 sent 3 boats of in pursuit of him half past 8 one of the boats got very handy to him but he saw the boat and took off at 10 lowered the 4th boat could not get on to him half past 11 the boats returned with out success made sail steered N.W. whale went off to the windward better luck next time I hope so ends Lat by Obs. 18° 16' Long by Obs. 148° 50'

Monday August 14th 1843 All these 24 hours brisk trades with pleasant weather steering N.W. with all sail set so ends Lat by Obs. 20° 10' Long by Obs. 151° 10'

Tuesday August 15th 1843 Commences with a brisk trade with pleasant weather steering N.W. middle part more moderate steering N.W. latter part very moderate trades steering N.W. by N finished painting the ship sent up the Main Mast so ends Lat by Obs. 21° 32' Long by Obs. 153° 30'

Wednesday August 16th 1843 Commences with a very moderate trade with fine pleasant weather steering N.W. middle part steering West wind and weather much the same at 9 A.M. made the Land Isle Maui bearing S.W. by S Dist by estimation 60 miles hauled the ship up S.W. so ends with a moderate trade. Lat by Obs. 21° 39' Long by Obs. 155° 20'

Ship Cambria at Anchor at Lahaina Isle Maui

Thursday August 17th 1843 Commences with a moderate trade with pleasant weather steering down for the Passage at 7 took in the Fore & Mizzen S.G.S. at 9 hauled up the courses headed off shore with the Main Top Sail to the mast at 1 A.M. were in shore with it to the mast at 4 kept off at day light made sail remainder of these 24 hours running down employed getting the ship ready so ends

Friday August 18th 1843 Commences with light airs and calms with pleasant weather at 5 P.M. came to at Lahaina in the Island Maui gave the ship day's provisions and furnished the sails found the following ships at anchor William Den of Salem 22 months out 55000 sperm 100000 whale & Montpelier of New Bedford 10 months out 100000 sperm middle part calms at 8 A.M. sent a raft of cork for water let one half go on shore so ends

Saturday August 19th 1843 Commences with fine pleasant weather employed blacking the ship's bottom at 7 the libertines came off latter part took our raft of water on board and let the other watch go on shore so ends employed painting the ship's stern and breaking out for hours.

Sunday August 20th 1843 Commences with pleasant weather variously employed one watch on shore at 7 P.M. they returned middle part all on board latter part the watch on liberty so ends

Monday August 21st 1843 All these 24 hours light breezes and calms ~~fair~~ and latter part one watch on liberty the other employed stowing water so ends.
