

Ship Cambria While Cruising About the Equator

Sunday May 5th 1844 Commences with a moderate trade and pleasant steering North at 4 P.M. took in the main Sail commenced boiling at 6 P.M. shortened Sail middle part moved at East steering by the wind to the N.E. at day light made Sail at 6 kept off N.W. & continued boiling at 9 when ship started N.W. set the main sail, sails. Lat by Obs. 1.15 Long by Obs. 121.50

Monday May 6th 1844 Commences with brisk trades and pleasant weather steering N.W. at 6 P.M. shortened Sail at 7 kept off West at day light made Sail latter part brisk trade and smoky weather steering N.W. so ends. Lat by Obs. 1.22 Long by Obs. 121.13

Tuesday May 7th 1844 Commences with brisk trades and pleasant weather steering S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened Sail luffed to the wind to the South middle part wind and weather much as the first part at day light set the courses & main S & at 6 veered ship latter part smoky weather so ends. Lat by Obs. 1.21 Long by Obs. 121.57

Wednesday May 8th 1844 Commences with brisk trades at East and smoky weather steering by the wind to the N.W. at 6 shortened Sail & veered ship at 10 veered again middle part more moderate at daylight made all Sail latter part moderate trades and smoky weather steering to the North saw Porpoises so ends. Lat by Obs. 1.00 Long by Obs. 121.10

Thursday May 9th 1844 All these 24 hours moderate trades with smoky weather saw Porpoises so ends. Lat by Obs. 1.05 Long by Obs. 121.05

Friday May 10th 1844 Commences with moderate trades and smoky weather steering by the wind to the N.W. at 6 P.M. shortened Sail at midnight veered ship at daylight made all Sail latter part pleasant employed firing new fore & main rigging and put back stays so ends. Lat by Obs. 1.30 Long by Obs. 121.00

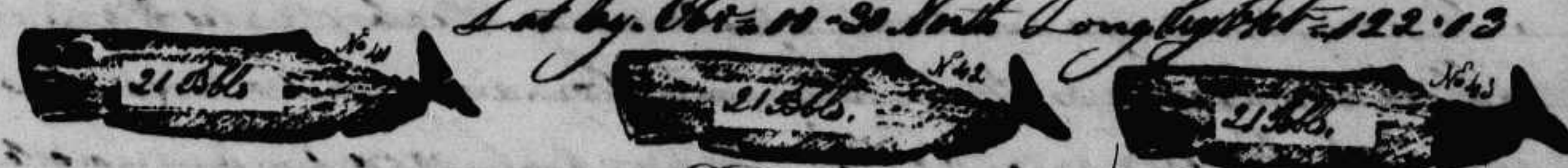
Ship Cambria While Cruising About the Equator

Saturday May 11th 1844 Commences with moderate trades and pleasant steering by the wind to the South middle part much the same at day light veered ship latter part brisk trade steering North by the wind. Lat by Obs. 32.0 Long by Obs. 121.05

Sunday May 12th 1844 Commences with a moderate trade from the Eastward steering N.W. middle part steering N.W. & latter part very moderate and very smoky steering N.W. so ends. Lat by Obs. 1.02 Long by Obs. 121.08

Monday 13th 1844 All these 24 hours moderate trades with very thick weather steering North and N.W. so ends. Lat by Obs. 00.14 Long by Obs. 121.32

Tuesday May 14th 1844 Commences moderate trades and thick smoky weather steering N.W. at 6 P.M. shortened Sail & luffed to the wind middle part brisk winds and clear weather at daylight veered ship made Sail at 6 kept off S.W. half past 6 saw 4 whales half past 8 lowered the boat struck a whale and turned them up at 10 took 2 of them to the ship kept off for the other half past 10 took the other along side at 11 commenced cupping brisk trades and pleasant so ends. Lat by Obs. 00.30 North Long by Obs. 122.13



Wednesday May 15th 1844 Commences with brisk trades and pleasant weather heading to the South employed boiling at 3 P.M. finished put away in the ship Sails & braced full on 1000 the foreve. at 8 P.M. commenced boiling at midnight veered ship middle part more moderate at daylight made Sail latter part moderate trades with pleasant weather steering N.W. employed boiling so ends. Lat by Obs. 01.05 North Long by Obs. 122.09
