

Ship Cambria from the N. W. Coast towards Maui I. Iles.

Sunday August 10th 1845 Commenced with a light air from the S. E. with pleasant weather middle part calm latter part a light breeze from S. E. to E. N. E. at 11 set the fore topmast standing sail steering South by Compass so ends. No observation Sun Observed.

Monday August 11th 1845 Commenced with a moderate breeze from the North with cloudy weather sun rain steering South at 6 set the main Royal & the wind halled to the N. W. shifted over the standing sail middle part moderate breeze and fair weather latter part nearly calm employed repairing the fore sail so ends. Lat by Obs. 29.24 Long by Est. 147.00

Tuesday August 12th 1845 All the 24 hours light air and calm with fine clear weather got part of our Bone up and dried it and stowed it away so ends. Lat by Obs. 29.12 Long by Est. 147.05

Wednesday August 13th 1845 Commenced with a light air from the South and pleasant steering by the wind to the S. E. middle part light air and calm at 10 A. M. the wind veered to the West and kept the ship South set the fore topmast standing sail latter part fair weather employed repairing the main sail so ends. Lat by Obs. 28.24

Thursday August 14th 1845 Commenced with light air from the N. W. with sun, foggy steering South middle and latter part wind from the North with cloudy weather on boat the bill to repair so ends. Lat by Obs. 27.02

Friday August 15th 1845 Commenced with a moderate breeze from the North with fair weather steering South riged out the fly jib boom and bent the sail middle part wind from the N. E. and cloudy latter part the same sun rain employed washing ship so ends. Lat by Obs. 26.36 Long by Est. 148.51

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Saturday ~~Monday~~ August 16th 1845 All the 24 hours about calm with fine clear weather latter part with the hold and got the remainder of our Bone on deck to dry so ends. Lat by Obs. 25.30 North.

Sunday ~~Tuesday~~ August 17th 1845 Commenced with a calm at 4 P. M. took a boat from the North put a new Boat out on the starboard cranes then set the topmast standing sail middle and latter part a moderate breeze from East to S. E. with pleasant weather so ends. Lat by Obs. 24.18 Long by Est. 148.35

Monday August 18th 1845 Commenced with a fine breeze from the Eastward with pleasant weather steering South middle part wind veering from East to S. E. with showers of rain steering S by W at 11 A. M. the wind got steady at East set the main & S. standing sail. latter part Carpenter employed repairing a boat so ends. Lat by Obs. 22.14 Long by Est. 149.50 West.

Tuesday August 19th 1845 First and middle part brisk winds from the Eastward steering S by W at 5 P. M. set a fore top Gallant all decky sail latter part sun squally employed battening the main rigging Carpenter employed repairing a boat so ends. Lat by Obs. 29.09 N Long by Est. 151.15 West.

Wednesday August 20th 1845 Commenced with moderate trades and pleasant steering S by W with all standing sail set at 6 P. M. took in the Bow Boat to repair middle part sun squally latter part much the same wind halled a head run took in the S. E. & Sails Carpenter employed on the bow Boat so ends. Lat by Obs. 27.59 Long by Est. 152.00

Thursday August 21th 1845 First and middle part of these 24 hours brisk trades from E by S with pleasant weather steering S by W middle part much the same latter part moderate put the bow Boat out on the cranes so ends. Lat by Obs. 25.58 Long by Est. 152.59
