[191] Saturday May 23rd 1846 Commences
with a moderate trade from the S. E. with pleasant weather steering N by E middle part much the same latter part wind from E. S. E. and already employed washing ship out side so ends.
Lat by Obs 1.25 S Long by Obs 34.31

[192] Sunday May 24th 1846
Commences with a moderate trade from the E. S. E. steering N by E middle part wind at East and very moderate latter part a moderate breeze from E. N. E. to East steering North and N by N. so ends.
Lat by Obs 0.28 N Long by Obs 35.06

[193] Monday May 25th 1846 Commences
with a moderate trade from East with pleasant weather steering North middle part a fine trade from E. S. E. to S. E. steering N by E latter part very moderate sun showers of rain so ends Lat by Obs 2.16 N Long 35.17

[194] Tuesday May 26th 1846 All these
24 hours light airs from E. S. E. to N. E. sun showers of rain so ends Lat by Obs 3.22 N Long by Obs 35.33

[195] Wednesday May 27th 1846
All these 24 hours light airs from the Eastward with sun showers of rain steering North and N by N with all drawing sail set so ends.

with a moderate breeze from N. E. in the lower standing sail at 2 P.M. took a strong breeze steering N. W. N. middle part a brisk trade from N. E. at 4 P.M. the wind veered to East set the lower standing sail latter part moderate trades with fine pleasant weather employed painting over spars mast heads &c so ends.

[198] Saturday May 30th 1846 Commences
with a moderate trade from East with fine pleasant weather steering N by N middle part brisk trades from N. E. steering N. W. N. all drawing sail set latter part more moderate steering N. W. N. employed painting spars so ends Lat by Obs 9.22 N Long by Obs 40.45

[199] Sunday May 31st 1846 All these
24 hours moderate trades with fine pleasant weather steering N. W. N. and N. W. N. with all the standing sail set so ends.
Lat by Obs 10.55 N Long by Obs 42.30 N.

[200] Monday June 1st 1846 Commences
with a moderate trade from the E. N. E. with fine pleasant weather steering N. W. N. middle part brisk trades latter part moderate employed painting the ships stern so ends. Lat by Obs 12.35 N Long by Obs 44.40

[201] Tuesday June 2nd 1846
All these 24 hours moderate trades from the E. N. E. with fine pleasant weather steering N. W. N. and N. W. N. with all drawing sail set latter part employed painting the ship outside so ends Lat by Obs 14.17 N Long by Obs 46.10
