

Ship Cambria from New Bedford Towards the Pacific Ocean

Sunday Feb 14th 1847 Commences with a light air from the S.W. with fair weather steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard middle and latter part much the same passed a number of vessels that were steering off to the North ends.

Lat by Obs. 2.45 N Long by Tobias Obs. 19.20

Monday Feb 15th 1847

All these 24 hours light breeze and calm standing to the South so ends Lat by Obs. 2.24

Tuesday Feb 16th 1847

Commences with a light air from the N.W. with fair weather steering S by W. W. middle part about calm latter part a very light air from the South standing to the Westward so ends.

Lat by Obs. 2.02 Long by Tobias Obs. 19.05

Wednesday Feb 17th 1847

Commences with a moderate breeze from the South with fair weather steering by the wind to the Westward middle part much the same at 7 A.M. sent 2 boats off to try and catch a Blackfish but they were too shy latter part moderate trades from S.E. saw a number of vessels steering off to the North so ends. Lat by Obs. 1.14 North Long by Tobias Obs. 19.26

Thursday Feb 18th 1847

Commences with a moderate trade from the S.E. with fair weather steering by the wind with the larboard tacks aboard at 1 P.M. took in the S.B. Sails in a squall middle part moderate trades made all sail latter part brisk trades from S.E. to S.W. with fair weather so ends. Lat by Obs. 00.36 South Long by Obs. 20.37

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Friday Feb 19th 1847 Commences with a brisk trade from S.E. to S.W. with fair weather steering by the wind with the larboard tacks aboard so ends.

Lat by Obs. 2.56 N Long by Obs. 21.47

Saturday Feb 20th 1847 Commences

with a brisk trade from S.E. with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the South West middle part brisk trades sun rain latter part more moderate with fine pleasant weather one vessel in sight ahead steering the same as ourselves so ends. Lat by Obs. 4.39 S Long by Tobias Obs. 23.40 West.

Sunday Feb 21st 1847 All these

24 hours fine trades with pleasant weather steering S.W. just a slick pull so ends.

Lat by Obs. 7.15

Monday Feb 22nd 1847 All these

24 hours moderate trades from S.E. to S.W. steering S.W. latter part had the top mast striding sail set so ends.

Lat by Obs. 9.39 Long by Tobias Obs. 26.36

Tuesday Feb 23rd 1847 Commences

with a moderate trade from the S.E. with pleasant weather steering S.W. hoisted the No. 1 Mast to repair the Cross Trees repaired them fixed the mast again so middle part moderate latter part the same sent the fore S.B. Mast 8 yard down to fill the horns and the Clasp down so and sent them up again set up the Riggings S.E. so ends Lat by Obs. 11.32 Long by Obs. 28.00 West.

Wednesday Feb 24th 1847 All

these 24 hours moderate trades and pleasant steering S.W. and S.W. by W. latter part employed turning up the Larboard No. 1 Riggings so ends. Lat by Obs. 13.7 Long by Obs. 29.35
