Ship Cambria from New Bedford towards the Pacific

Thursday Feb 25th 1847

All these 24 hours vary moderate trades from East to E N E steering S W fine pleasant weather turned up the Main Tackling so ends.

Lat by Obs. 14. 27 S Long by both Obs. 30. 35

Friday Feb 26th 1847 Commences

with a moderate trade from East steering S W. sent the M Royal yard up set the sail middle and latter part a fine breeze. latter part saw 2 or 3 befalls turned up the Main Tackling so ends.

Lat by Obs. 16. 09 South.

Saturday Feb 27th 1847 Commences

with a fine breeze from E N E steering S W sun rain middle and latter part fine breezes from E N E and pleasant steering S W. so ends. Lat by Obs. 18. 09 Long by Obs. 33. 25

Sunday Feb 28th 1847 Commences

with a fine breeze from the E N E with fine pleasant weather steering S W middle and latter part much the same saw one befall so ends. Lat by Obs. 20. 19 S Long by Obs. 35. 28

Monday March 1st 1847 All

these 24 hours fine breezes from N E to E N E with pleasant weather steering S W saw one or two befalls latter part employed turning up the fore Tackling so ends. Lat by Obs. 22. 05 Long by Obs. 37. 55

Tuesday March 2nd 1847

All these 24 hours fine breezes from about North with fine pleasant weather steering S W by W variously employed about the Tackling during sun so ends.

Lat by Obs. 23. 54 Long by Obs. 38. 42

Ship Cambria from New Bedford towards the Pacific Ocean

Wednesday March 3rd 1847 Commences

with a fine breeze at North with pleasant weather steering S W by W middle part wind at N W and moderate latter part calm so ends. Lat by Obs. 25. 31 Long by Obs. 40. 41

Thursday March 4th 1847

Commences with a light air from the South with sun rain latter part light air from the S E and calm with pleasant weather latter part a moderate breeze from the S E with fine pleasant weather steering S W by W employed battling and turning the fore Tackling so ends. Lat by Obs. 25. 58 South.

Friday March 5th 1847

Commences with a moderate breeze from the S E with fine pleasant weather steering S W by W middle part wind from N E and vary moderate sun rain latter part vary light air from E N E with fair weather employed battling down the Main Tackling so ends.

Lat by Obs. 26. 49 South.

Saturday March 6th 1847 Commences

with a moderate breeze from the E N E with fair weather steering S W by W middle part much the same latter part thick rain weather but vary moderate breezes from the E N E so ends. No Observation.

Sunday March 7th 1847 Commences

with a moderate breeze from the E N E with cloudy weather steering S W by W middle part much the same latter part brisk wind with fair weather so ends.
