

Ship Cambria While Cruising About the Equator

Thursday May 20th 1847 Commences

with a moderate trade with fair weather steering N.W. by N at sunset shortened sail middle part wind and weather much as the first part at daylight made sail at 6 A.M. kept off W by S at 10 hauled up S.W. latter part brisk trade Carpenter employed on the Potatoes so ends. Lat by Obs. 00.20 S Long by Obs. 114.05 West.

Friday May 21st 1847

Commences with a brisk trade with fair weather steering S.W. at sunset kept off W by N set the main royal middle part fine trade at daylight hauled up. The W took in the main royal latter part moderate smoky weather Carpenter employed on the Pen so ends.

Lat by Obs. 00.05 S Long by Obs. 105.25

Saturday May 22nd 1847 Commences

with a moderate trade steering S.W. middle part nearly calm steering W by S latter part moderate steering W.S.W. so ends. Lat by Obs. 00.11 S Long by Obs. 106.46

Sunday May 23rd 1847

Commences with a moderate trade steering S.W. saw Porpoises middle and latter part steering W.S.W. so ends. Lat by Obs. 00.13 S Long by Obs. 108.10

Monday May 24th 1847 Commences

with a fine trade with pleasant weather steering S.W. with all sail set middle part a fine breeze steering N.W. by N latter part more moderate steering W.S.W. hauled up our Chane Cable set all hands at work pecking the rust off it so ends.

Lat by Obs. 00.30 S Long by Obs. 110.00

Tuesday May 25th 1847 Commences

with a fine trade from the S.E. steering S.W. by N at 6 P.M. finished the Chane, ready for biling middle part a faint rain steering W by S latter part nearly calm under the Chane and stowed it below so ends. Lat by Obs. 00.18 S Long by Obs. 111.00

Wednesday May 26th 1847 Commences

with a moderate trade from East steering S.W. sun showers of rain middle part thick weather latter part a fine breeze at East with fair weather steering S.W. employed repairing a Top Sail Carpenter employed on the Pen so ends.

Lat by Obs. 00.54 S Long by Obs. 112.00

Thursday May 27th 1847 Commences

with a fine trade at East steering S.W. by N at 6 P.M. kept off W by N shifted over the Standing Sail middle part fine trade latter part the same steering N.W. on bent the main S.G. Sail repaired it and bent it again so ends.

Lat by Obs. 00.47 S Long by Obs. 113.40

Friday May 28th 1847 Commences

with a fine trade with fair weather steering N.W. middle part wind and weather much as the first part steering N.W. latter part much the same so ends.

Lat by Obs. 00.23 N Long by Obs. 116.48

Saturday May 29th 1847

All these 24 hours moderate trades from the Eastward with pleasant weather steering W by S and N.W. so ends. Lat by Obs. 00.15 S Long by Obs. 115.47

Sunday May 30th 1847 All these 24 hours

moderate trades and fine pleasant weather steering N.W. by N and West with all sail set so ends.

Lat by Obs. 00.09 N Long by Obs. 117.08 West
