

Ship Cambria While Cruising About the Equator

Thursday Oct. 7th 1847 Commences with a moderate trade from the Eastward with pleasant weather steering N.W. at 5 P.M. luffed to the wind to the North at sunset tacked and to the light sails middle part moderate at day light made all sail latter part fine pleasant weather ends.
Lat by Obs. 10.28 S Long by Obs. 173.53

Friday Oct. 8th 1847 Commences with a moderate trade with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the S.E. at sunset took in the light sails middle part much as the first part at 6 P.M. tacked at 7 saw three whales bearing West kept off for them at 8 saw them again a long distance off about 11 saw the Whales going quick to the Westward lowered away the boats three 24 hours ends in chasing Whales

Saturday Oct. 9th 1847 Commences with a very moderate trade boats off in chase of Whales struck one and parted from him after he run 10 or 12 miles to the windward half struck one and drove in 5 minutes at 4 P.M. boats returned without success lost 2 fathoms and 40 or 50 fathoms of line middle part very light airs at 1 P.M. pressed ship to the North latter part a fine trade from about East with fine pleasant weather so ends.
Lat by Obs. 11.59 S Long by Obs. 174.23

Sunday Oct. 10th 1847 Commences with a moderate trade from the Eastward with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the South at 5 P.M. tacked to the N.W. & luffed back again middle part moderate the light sail in at daylight made sail at 6 P.M. tacked latter part brisk trade and pleasant so ends Lat 10.41 S Long 174.28

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Monday Oct. 11th 1847 Commences with a brisk trade from the Eastward with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the North at 6 P.M. tacked at sunset took in the light sails middle part moderate at daylight made all sail latter part moderate pleasant weather steering S.E. so ends. Lat 11.08 S Long by Obs. 174.09

Tuesday Oct. 12th 1847 Commences with a moderate trade from the Eastward with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the S.E. at sunset shortened sail middle part light airs and calm latter part moderate trade steering by the wind to the N.W. saw blackfish and Porpoises so ends.
Lat by Obs. 1.30 S Long by Obs. 174.6

Wednesday Oct. 13th 1847 Commences with a moderate trade from the East steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard at sunset tacked to the South and shortened sail middle part very moderate at daylight made all sail at 6 P.M. tacked latter part very moderate saw a plenty of Porpoises so ends.
Lat by Obs. 1.16 S Long by Obs. 174.22

Thursday Oct. 14th 1847 Commences with a moderate trade from the N.E. with pleasant weather steering by the wind with the larboard tacks aboard middle part much the same at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.W. latter part a brisk trade from N.W. with pleasant weather so ends.
Lat by Obs. 1.35 S Long by Obs. 174.32

Friday Oct. 15th 1847 Commences with a brisk trade from the N.E. with fair weather steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard middle part very moderate at 6 P.M. tacked to the S.E. at 10 P.M. tacked back to the N.W. latter part moderate trade sun squally so ends.
Lat by Obs. 10.44 S Long by Obs. 174.41
