

Ship Cambria While Cruising in the South Pacific Ocean

Thursday Jan^y 13th 1848 Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. with cloudy weather steering N by E at 7 P.M. shortened sail and were round to the wind to the South middle part vary moderate at daylight set the courses of fore & half part kept off N.W. the wind began to blow on after sunrise at 1 put 2 reef in the top sail furled the main sail at 10 luffed to the wind to the N.E. remains part moderate gales with fair weather so ends. Lat by Obsⁿ 29° 54' Long by Estⁿ 180° 30 West

Friday Jan^y 14th 1848 Commences with a brisk wind from the E.S.E. with fair weather at 6 P.M. wore ship to the South at 1 took in the fore middle part more moderate at daylight set the fore at 1 set the main course but a part brisk winds from E.S.E. one vessel in sight under our lee so ends.

Lat by Obsⁿ 30° 14' S Long by Estⁿ 181° 00

Saturday Jan^y 15th 1848 Commences with a moderate gale from the E.S.E. with clear weather at 5 P.M. took in the main course at 7 took in the fore & main were ship then took in the fore & main top sail middle part wind and weather much as the last part at daylight set the fore top sail latter part vary rugged whale weather two vessels passed to the weather of us at 12 were round to the South to ends. Lat by Obsⁿ 30° 05' S Long by Estⁿ 181° 00

Sunday Jan^y 16th 1848 Commences with a moderate gale from the E.S.E. with fair weather standing to the South under short sail at 7 P.M. wore ship took in the fore top sail middle part more moderate at daylight set the fore top sail & fore half part were ship at 10 A.M. set the main sail and spanker latter part more moderate a prospect of better whale weather so ends.

Lat by Obsⁿ 30° 31' S Long by Estⁿ 181° 15

Monday Jan^y 17th 1848 S.W. there 24 hours moderate breeze from the S.E. with fair weather steering by the wind part the time to the N.E. and part the time to the South one vessel in sight so ends.

Lat by Obsⁿ 30° 17' Long by Estⁿ 180° 35

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Tuesday Jan^y 18th 1848 Commences with a brisk wind from the S.E. with fair weather steering by the wind to the S.W. half part 6 P.M. took in the main sail M.D.E. at 10 and spanker middle part vary moderate breeze from S.E. to N.W. half part 5 made sail latter part brisk wind from the S.W. with fair weather steering E.S.E. so ends. Lat by Obsⁿ 30° 49' S Long by Estⁿ 180° 00 the barometer is down rather lower than usual at below 29°

Wednesday Jan^y 19th 1848 Commences with a brisk wind from the S.W. with clear weather steering E.S.E. at 5 P.M. made French Hook bearing S.E. Dist by estimation 20 miles at 6 saw 2 vessels to the South at 7 shortened sail too soon to reef fore & main top sail & fore sail middle part moderate gales steering E.S.E. latter part wind and weather much the same steering N.E. so ends. Lat by Obsⁿ 31° 17' Long by Estⁿ 181° 46

Thursday Jan^y 20th 1848 Commences with a brisk wind from the S.W. with fair weather steering N.E. at 7 P.M. luffed to the wind to the S.E. took in the fore top sail middle part moderate at daylight set the top sails at half past 5 P.M. wore ship made all sail latter part a moderate breeze from the South steering N by W to ends. Lat by Obsⁿ 30° 45' S Long by Estⁿ 181° 01

Friday Jan^y 21st 1848 Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. with fair weather steering N by W at 7 P.M. shortened sail luffed to the wind to the S.W. middle part moderate breeze from the S.E. half part 5 P.M. kept off N by E and made sail latter part a moderate breeze with cloudy weather saw a ship steering to the North so ends. No Observation. Lat 30° 15' S Long by Estⁿ 181° 33

Saturday Jan^y 22nd 1848 Commences with a moderate trade from the Eastwards steering N by S at 8 P.M. made Macaulay's Isle bearing N.W. Dist 25 miles. at 7 P.M. shortened sail & luffed to the wind middle part vary moderate at daylight kept off for the Island at 10 sent 2 boats in to see if they could get down boats but they could not land ahead an hour and caught a few fish at 12 they returned took up the boats kept off so ends. Lat by Obsⁿ 30° 18' 30 South this is the lat of this Island
