

Ship Cambria While Cruising About the Sydney Group.
Sunday Nov. 25th 1849 Commences with

a very light air from the Eastward with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the S.E. middle and latter part about Calm so each.

Lat by Obs. 3° 38' S Long by Obs. 174° 44'

Monday Nov. 26th 1849 First and middle part calm with pleasant weather latter part a breeze from the North fine clear & pleasant on board the Spanker and repaired it & mends.

Lat by Obs. 3° 25' S Long by Obs. 175° 16' West.

Tuesday Nov. 27th 1849 All three 24 hours a fine breeze from the North with beautiful pleasant weather first part stood to the Westward with all sail set at 6 P.M. took both masts light sails & mended the main sail latter part all sail set Lat by Obs. 3° 29' S Long 174° 40'

Wednesday Nov. 28th 1849 Commences with a fine breeze at North at 1 P.M. made McKeans Island bearing E.S.E. Dist 12 miles. middle part moderate latter part nearly Calm on bent the Fore top sail to repair & mends Lat by Obs. 3° 20' S Long 173° 31'

Thursday Nov. 29th 1849 Commences with light airs and calm at 4 P.M. it commenced raining and rained until 8 P.M. then held up bent the Fore & I put 2 reefs in it and reefed the others middle part very moderate breeze from the S.E. at daylight made all sail latter part moderate trades and pleasant & mends Lat 3° 30' S Long 173° 12'

Friday Nov. 30th Commences with a moderate breeze from the E.S.E. with fair weather steering by the wind to the N.E. all sail set at sunset took in the light sails middle part much as the first at daylight had a squall which split the J.B. a little took it in and repaired it latter part moderate breeze from E.N.E. to N.E. & mends Lat by Obs. 2° 30' S Long by Obs. 172° 51' West.

Saturday Dec. 1st 1849 All three 24 hours moderate trades and pleasant weather steering by the wind to the North Lat by Obs. 1° 29' S Long by Obs. 174° 00'

Sunday Dec. 2nd 1849 Commences with a moderate trades and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. took to the S.E. middle and latter part fine pleasant Lat by Obs. 2° 34' South. Long by Obs. 173° 35'

Monday Dec. 3rd 1849 All three 24 hours moderate trades from N.E. to N.W. with fair weather standing to the Eastward with all sail set & mends Lat by Obs. 3° 12' S Long by Obs. 172° 38' West.

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Tuesday Dec. 4th 1849 All three 24

hours fine trades and a few rain squalls latter part heaved to the westward in sight of Birnie's Island & mends Lat by Obs. 3° 31' South.

Wednesday Dec. 5th 1849 All three 24 hours brisk trades from N.E. with fair weather steered by the wind little on one tack and little on the other run off some bird saw nothing at the Whales

Lat by Obs. 3° 18' S Long by Obs. 172° 15' West.

Thursday Dec. 6th 1849 Commences with a brisk trade with fair weather steering by the wind to the N.W. at 7 P.M. spoke the Ship Louper of Bedford about 10 months out 2200 lbs. Whales 110 Spenn middle and latter part brisk trades half part 9 P.M. sprung the M & I mast took in the sail & mends Louper in sight off our lee Lat by Obs. 1° 52' S Long by Obs. 172° 41'

Friday Dec. 7th 1849 Commences with a brisk trade at 6 spoke the Courier and got a spar for J. Gallant mast middle part more moderate at 6 P.M. wore ship to the South at 7 kept off West 10 ends Lat by Obs. 1° 06' S Long by Obs. 173° 40'

Saturday Dec. 8th 1849 All three 24 hours moderate trades from the N.E. with fair weather and all prospects & mends Lat by Obs. 2° 14' S Long by Obs. 173° 55'

Sunday Dec. 9th 1849 All three 24 hours moderate breezes from the N.E. and pleasant Lat 3° 18' S Long 173° 39'

Monday Dec. 10th 1849 All three 24 hours moderate trades and fine pleasant weather latter part employed making a S.S. M. & mends Lat by Obs. 4° 00' S Long by Obs. 173° 27'

Tuesday Dec. 11th 1849 First and middle part moderate trades and pleasant steering West and N.W. at daylight made McKeans Island bearing 16 by N at 7 halted a back under the lee of it & pulled in caught a mesh of fish landed on it and got a few Eggs. at 10 returned kept off West & mends.

Wednesday Dec. 12th 1849 Commences with a brisk wind and fair weather steering N.W. middle part more moderate latter part very moderate & mends Lat 2° 24' S Long by Obs. 175° 50'

Thursday Dec. 13th 1849 First part very light airs steering South middle part steering N.W. latter part wind from N.W. steering by the wind putting new throat seizing on our main rigging & mends Lat by Obs. 3° 48' S Long by Obs. 177° 00' West.
