Monday Nov. 25th Commences with

bisk trades and fair weather with a bad sea the Ship takes in a good deal of Water over her Bow took in the fore & main Sails, middle part much the same latter part more moderate wind from S E set the main S E Sail at 12 let the reef out of the main S E Sail so ends

Ship takes about 1400 keels in 24 hours

Lat by Obs. 26.11 Long 158.50

Tuesday Nov. 26th Commences with a brisk wind from the S E with fair weather steering by the wind to the S W at 4 P.M. let the reef out of the S E Sails middle part moderate breeze from S E to East latter part light baffling winds from South to S E steering by the wind to the Eastward and bent the fore S E Sails middle stitched it and bent it again so ends Lat by Obs. 27.12

Wednesday Nov. 27th Commences

with a light air and baffling with pleasant weather middle part much the same latter part a moderate breeze from the S W with fine pleasant weather steering S E with all the S E Sails set so ends Lat by Obs. 27.11 South

Ship takes about 1500 keels in 24 hours

Thursday Nov. 28th Commences with

a moderate breeze from the N W with fine pleasant weather steering S E with all sail set took a little more sheathing up off deck for fire wood middle part wind much as the first part at 3 P.M. the wind backed to the S W backed in the S E Sails and the yards up sharp latter part moderate breeze from S W to S E with fine pleasant weather Lat by Obs. 28.30 Long by Tobias Obs. 157.00 by Parkell 157.26

Friday Nov. 29th All these 24 hours

moderate breezes from S E to South with pleasant weather steering by the wind with the starboard tack aboard & all sail set so ends Lat by Obs. 28.39 Long by Tobias Obs. 154.41 by Parkell 154.37 West

Saturday Nov. 30th All these 24 hours

moderate breezes from South to S E with pleasant weather steering by the wind with the starboard tack aboard & all sail set so ends Lat by Obs. 29.35 Long by Tobias Obs. 152.47 by Parkell 152.57

Sunday December 1st All these 24 hours

light air from South to S E with fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Eastward so ends the last 3 or 4 days we have had a heavy swell from the South. Lat 29.47 Long by Obs. 151.42 W 152.39

Monday Dec. 2nd All these 24 hours

light air and calm latter part thick weather with some rain some four days or less down have them overboard so ends No observations

Tuesday Dec. 3rd All these 24 hours

light variable winds from South to S E with fine weather so ends Lat by Obs. 30.54 Long by Obs. 151.43 W 151.37

Wednesday Dec. 4th Commences

with a moderate breeze from the S E with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the South middle part wind from S E steering S E latter part wind from North to N E set all the S E Sails & steered S E fine pleasant weather with the exception of one Rain squall Lat by Obs. 32.22 Long by Obs. 151.38 West 151.29

Thursday Dec. 5th Commences with

brisk winds from the N E with fair weather steering S E backed in the S E Sails and braced up sharp middle part the wind increased took in all the light Sails put a reef in the fore & main S E Sails latter part wind from East to S E more moderate let the reef out of the fore S E Sails set the fore & main S E Sails & steered weather Lat by Obs. 34.40 Long by Obs. 150.00 151.3

Friday Dec. 6th Commences with a brisk

wind from the Eastward at 1 P.M. took in the fore S E Sails at 5 took in the main at 7 put one reef in the S E Sails middle part more moderate latter part the same with pleasant weather let the reef out of the fore & main S E Sails set the main S E Sails & steered Lat by Obs. 36.48 Long by Obs. 149.25 149.25

[42 days] Saturday Dec. 7th Commences with a

brisk wind from the Eastward with fair weather steering by the wind to the S E middle part much the same S E Sails & steered latter part moderate breezes and fair weather all Sails set Lat by Obs. 38.58 Long by Obs. 148.34 148.58

Sunday December 8th Commences with

a moderate breeze from the Eastward with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the S E with all sail set middle and latter part much the same so ends Lat by Obs. 40.46 Long by Obs. 148.5 148.9
