Sunday Decr 22<sup>th</sup> Com. menes with

a moderate gale from W by N steering East wind in at 11 o'clock moderate  
let all the reef out of the Main top sail at 5 P.M. let one reef out of  
the Fore top sail & the Mizzen top sail & Main & Gallant sail, middle part  
a fine breeze with moderate weather let all the reef out of the Fore & Mizzen  
top sails at 6 let the Fore & Main Royals at 7 let the top, mast & S. & S. Sailing  
the fore rope of the Fore Royal parted Sail split nearly in two at 8 P.M. the  
Main got so over the same way parted it & halled in the S. G. Sail  
ends with a fine breeze & fair weather to end.

Standing Sails of Royal split the Fore Royal latter part more moderate  
with and cloudy at all the Standing Sails sent the Fore Royal yard down  
repaired the Sail set it up again wind moderating away and halling  
out to the North so on do. No Observations Lat about 51.56 Long 107.40

Wednesday Decr 25<sup>th</sup> Com. menes with

a light air from the North with thick rainey weather at 2 P.M. halled in  
all the Standing Sails at 5 P.M. a brisk breeze sprang up from WNW steering  
E by N at 9 had a squall from the South called all hands took in  
the S. G. Sails Main Sail put 2 reefs in the top Sails the wind from moderate  
down and halled round to the West made all Sail Standing Sails below  
and aloft latter part moderate breeze from North to WNW with thick  
foggy weather to end. No Observations.

E by N with all drawing Sail set middle part the wind unsteady evening  
a hauling from North to West halled in all the Standing Sails once in the  
evening & set them again from 5 to 6 A.M. latter part fine moderate breeze  
from W by S and pleasant breeze Lat 52.37

moderate breeze from the NW with fine pleasant weather steering E by N at  
with all drawing Sail set middle part wind more to the South at 2 A.M.  
halled in the lower Standing Sail latter part light air to the S.E. and East  
halled in all the Standing Sails and hauled up sharp to end.

middle part wind increased took in the Royal Fly jib & Mizzen S. G.

top Sails sent the Royal yards down & ended No Observations

Monday Decr 30<sup>th</sup> Com. menes with

brisk winds from the N.E. with thick rainey weather took in the  
Main Course at 5 P.M. the wind left us now a nice calm in the  
mid night then a breeze sprang up from the S.E. with it increased to  
a gale took in the jib & Courses & Mizzen top sail latter part moderate  
gale from S. E. with flying Clouds Lat by Obs 54.27

Tuesday Decr 31<sup>st</sup> 1850 Com. menes

with a brisk gale from the South with fair weather steering E by N  
double reef Fore & Main top Sails the ears of Fore & Main top sail set middle  
part more moderate latter part still more moderate set the Courses  
jib Mizzen top sail & S. G. Sails & ended Lat 54.04 Long by Obs 88.00 88.9

Wednesday January 1<sup>st</sup> 1851 Com. menes

with a brisk breeze from the South with fair weather steering E by N at 6 P.M.  
he sent the Fore & Main Royal yards up and set the sails at 8 the wind  
veered a little to the Westward set the top mast Standing Sail at 6 set the Fore  
and Main Sails at 10 the wind veered to the WNW set the Lower S. S. at 7  
A.M. set the top mast Standing Sail latter part brisk wind with foggy  
to end Lat about 54.30 South.

Thursday Jan 2<sup>nd</sup> Com. menes with a brisk

wind from the Westward with foggy weather steering East by Comp. set all our  
Standing Sails set middle part more at the same latter part wind from the S. E. foggy  
at 11 P.M. sent to Lat by Obs 55.26 South Long by Obs 78.11
