Monday January 13th Commenced with brisk wind from the N.W. with fine pleasant weather by the wind to the N.E. middle part moderate breezes at Noath latter part vary moderate from N.W. to N.E. with cloudy weather Lat by Obs. 39.58 South.

Tuesday Jan 14th Commenced with a light air from the N.E. which finally died away calm at 5 a light air sprang up at 8 P.M. which increased to a gale by midnight took in the all the light sails put 2 reefs in the top sails steered N by E & latter part more moderate let the reef out set top Gallant Sails Royals and top mast & 1st standing sails secured No Observations.

Wednesday Jan 15th Commenced with a brisk wind from the N.E. with cloudy weather steering N by E & middle part moderate with some rain latter part more pleasant wind halting on to the Eastward all the standing sails set secured.

Thursday Jan 16th Commenced with a moderate breeze from the E. S. E. with pleasant weather steering N.N.E. at 7 P.M. the wind halled to East halled in all the standing sails middle part vary moderate at 8 P.M. the wind halled to N.N.E. tooked ship latter part vary light airs at Noath with fine pleasant weather employed making trawling stuff secured.

Friday Jan 17th All there 24 hours moderate breezes from Noath to N.N.E. with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Eastward and all sail set secured.

Saturday Jan 18th Commenced with a light air from N.E. by N with cloudy weather steering by the wind to the Eastward middle part the wind increased to N.W. at 5 P.M. set the top mast and top & standing sails wind increased to N.W. steered N.N.E. at 10 the wind died away & only calm halled out to Noath thick cloudy weather No Observations.

Sunday January 19th Commenced with a light air from the N.E. with cloudy weather at 6 P.M. the wind left us at 11 took a breeze from N.W. with the standing sails steered N.N.E. at 2 P.M. passed a vessel that was by the wind to the S.E. latter part moderate breezes with thick rainy weather steering N.N.E. & E with all drawing sail set and some that would not draw so much No Observations.

Monday Jan 20th Commenced with moderate breezes from the S.W. with thick rainy weather steering N by N with all drawing sail set at 5 P.M. the weather cleared off middle part moderate pleasant weather with considerable swell from the N.N.E. latter part the wind halled round to the S.E. fine pleasant weather employed sitting up the top mast rigging secured.

Tuesday Jan 21th Commenced with a fine breeze from the E. S. E. with pleasant weather steering N.N.E. at 9 A.M. the wind halled more & halled on the standing sails middle part some showers of rain latter part fine pleasant weather steering by the wind heading N.E. by E 10 ends.

Wednesday Jan 22th All there 24 hours moderate breezes from E.S.E. to S.E. with pleasant weather steering N.E. by N with all drawing sail set latter part employed cleaning and blacking the iron work about the ship secured.

Lat by Obs. 29.17 Long by Obs. 37.45

Thursday Jan 23th Commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.E. with pleasant weather steering N.E. with all drawing sail set middle and latter part nearly calm & vary light air from the S.E. a brig in sight standing to the Eastward by the wind, employed cleaning and blacking the iron work secured.

Lat by Obs. 28.22 Long by Obs. 36.11

Friday Jan 24th Commenced with a calm at 6 P.M. took a breeze from the E.N.E. steered by the wind to the north middle part light air from N.E. to E.S.E. at 5 P.M. set the standing sails at 8 the wind left us at 11 took a breeze from the N.N.W. steered to the N.E. a ship in sight steering S.W. secured Lat 27.32
