

KNITTED EDGING.

FIGURE No. 2.—Cast on 15 stitches. ("O 2" means "over twice.")

First row.—Sl 1, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o 2, n, k 6.
Second row.—K 8, p 1, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 3.
Third row.—Sl 1, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 11.
Fourth row.—K 11, o 2, p 2 to, k 8.
Fifth row.—Sl 1, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o 2, n, o 2, n, k 5.
Sixth row.—K 7, p 1, k 2, p 1, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 3.
Seventh row.—Sl 1, k 3, o 2, p 2 to, k 13.
Eighth row.—K 13, o 2, p 2 to, k 3.

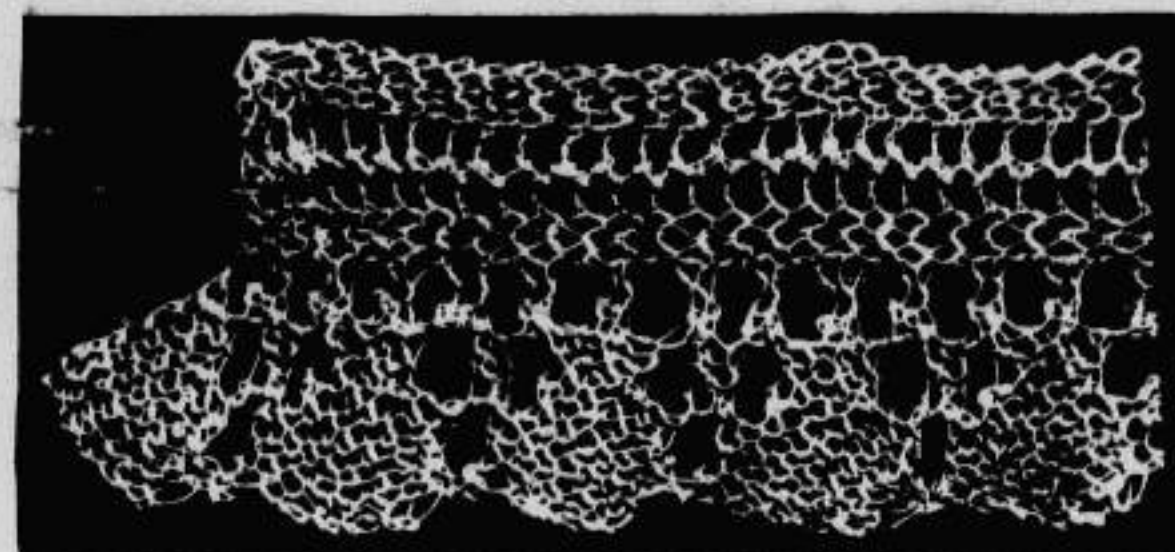


FIGURE No. 2.—KNITTED EDGING.

Ninth row.—Sl 1, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o 2, n, o 2, n, k 5.
Tenth row.—K 7, p 1, k 2, p 1, k 2, p 1, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 3.
Eleventh row.—Sl 1, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 9, draw last 5 stitches over 6th, k 1.
Twelfth row.—Narrow, k 9, o 2, p 2 to, k 3.

KNITTED BORDER FOR DOILIES, HANDKERCHIEFS OR CENTER-PIECES.

FIGURE No. 1.—Use thread or knitting cotton of any fineness desired and cast on 25 stitches:

First row.—Sl 1, k 7, n, o, n, k 8, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, k 2.
Second row.—and all even rows plain.
Third row.—Sl 1, k 6, n, o, n, o, k 2, n, o 2, n, k 3, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o, k 2.
Fourth row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o 2, n, o, n, o, k 1, n, o 2, n, n, o 2, n, k 1, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, n, o, k 2.

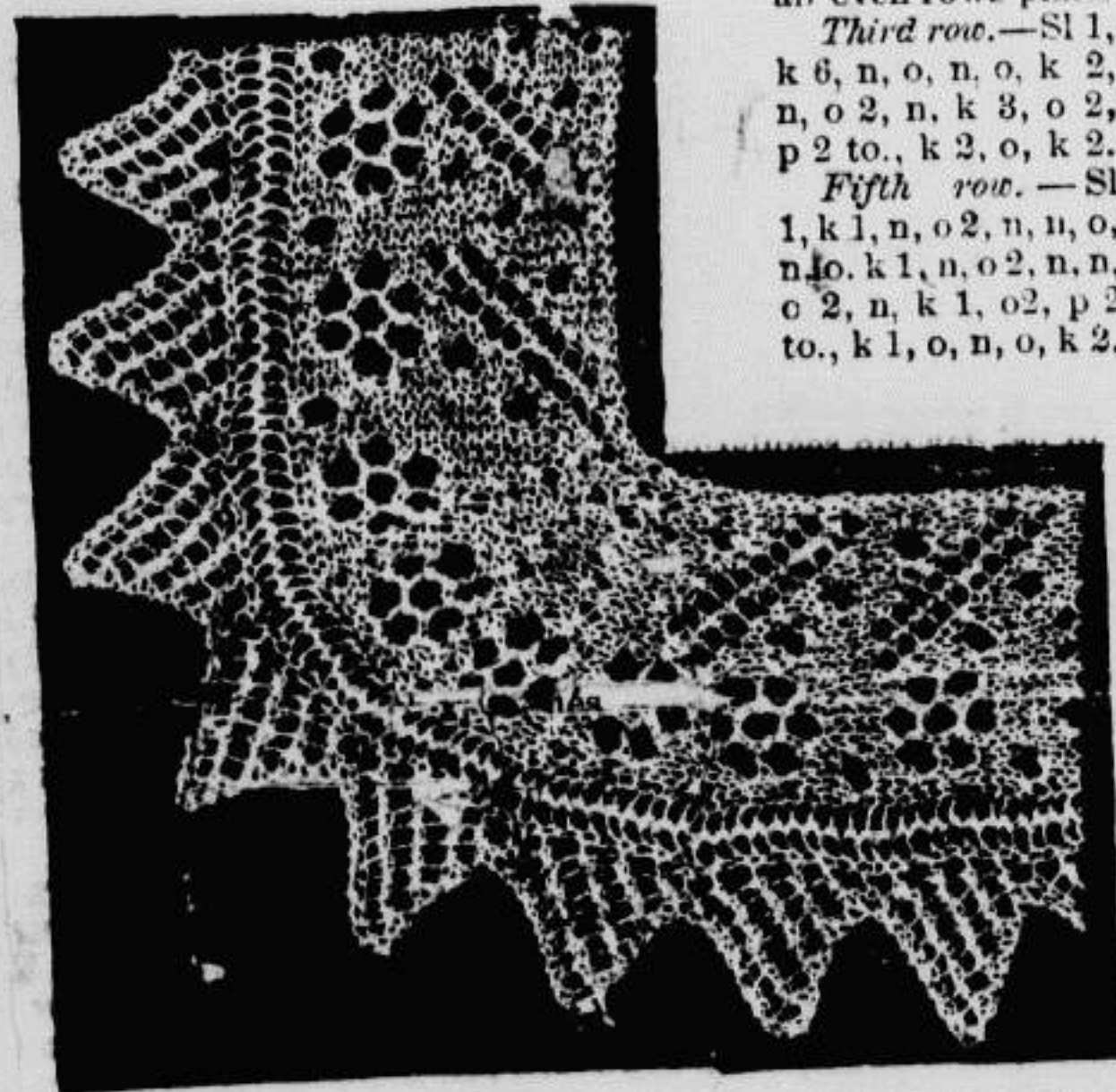


FIGURE No. 1.—KNITTED BORDER FOR DOILIES, HANDKERCHIEFS OR CENTER-PIECES.

Seventh row.—Sl 1, k 4, n, o, n, o, k 4, n, o 2, n, k 3, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o, n, o, k 2.
Ninth row.—Sl 1, k 2, n, o, n, o, k 3, n, o 2, n, n, o 2, n, k 1, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, n, o, n, o, k 2.
Eleventh row.—Sl 1, k 2, n, o, n, o, k 1, n, o 2, n, k 1, n, o 2, n, k 3, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o, n, o, n, o, k 2.
Thirteenth row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, n, o, k 14, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, n, o, n, o, k 2.
Fifteenth row.—Sl 1, n, o, n, o, k 15, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o, n, o, n, o, n, o, k 2.
Seventeenth row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, k 1, n, o 2, n, k 7, n, o 2, n, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, n, o, n, o, k 2.
Nineteenth row.—Sl 1, n, o, k 17, o 2, p 2 to, k 12.
Twentieth row.—Bind off 9, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 20.
Repeat 4 times more (but if used for any other article repeat the required length before turning the corner. For corner use with same stitches.
Twenty-first row.—Sl 1, k 13, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, k 2.
Twenty-second row.—K 4, o 2, p 2 to, k 18, leave 2.
Twenty-third row.—Sl 1, k 10, n, o 2, n, k 3, o 2, p 2 to, goods, might be ok.

BIAS LACE.

FIGURE No. 1.—Use Barbour's Irish flax thread. Cast on 47 stitches.

First row.—O 2, p 2 to, k 5, p 1, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 3, n, o 2, n, k 5, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 3, n, o 2, k 3, o 2, n 3 to, loop on 5 sts., k 2.
Second row.—Bind off 4, k 4, p 1, k 4, p 1, k 4, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 7, p 1, k 4, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to, k 6, to 2, p 2 to.
Third row.—O 2, p 2 to, k 6, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 3, n, o 2, n, k 5, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to, o, p 2 to, k 5, n, o 2, k 3, o 2, n 3 to, loop on 5 sts., k 2.
Fourth row.—Bind off 4, k 4, p 1, k 4, p 1, k 4, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 6, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 3, n, o 2, n, k 5, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to, o, p 2 to, k 5, n, o 2, k 3, o 2, n 3 to, loop on 5 sts., k 2.
Fifth row.—O 2, p 2 to, k 8, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 3, n, o 2, n, k 5, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to, o, sl 1, n, b 1, k 4, n, o 2, n, k 1, o 2, n 3 to, loop on 5 sts., k 2.
Sixth row.—Bind off 4, k 4, p 1, n, k 1, p 1, k 7, p 1 in last stitch making 2 of it, o, p 2 to, o, p 2 to, k 7, p 1, k 4, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 8, o 2, p 2 to.
Seventh row.—O 2, p 2 to, k 10, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 3, n, o 2, n, k 5, o 2, p 2 to, k 5, n, o 2, n, n 3 to, o 2, n 3 to, loop on 5 sts., k 2.
Eighth row.—Bind off 4, k 4, p 1, n, k 1, p 1, k 6, o 2, p 2 to, k 7, p 1, k 4, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 10, o 2, p 2 to.
Ninth row.—O 2, p 2 to, k 12, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 3, n, o 2, n, k 8, n, o 2, n, n 3 to, o 2, n 3 to, loop on 5 sts., k 2.
Tenth row.—Bind off 4, k 4, p 1, n, k 1, p 1, k 11, p 1, k 4, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 12, o 2, p 2 to.
Eleventh row.—O 2, p 2 to, k 5, n, o 2, n, k 5, o 2, p 2 to, o, p 2 to 3 times, k 3, n, o 2, n, k 4, n, o 2, n, n 3 to, o 2, n 3 to, Turn the work.

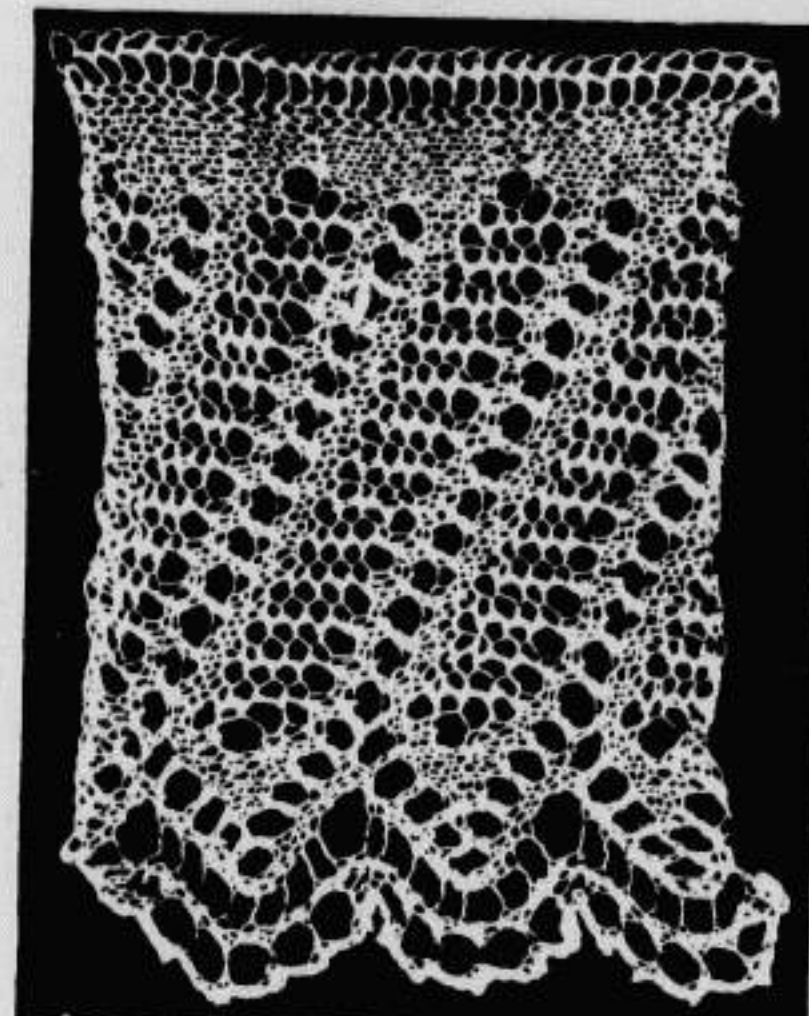


FIGURE No. 1.—BIAS LACE.

Fourth row.—K 5, o 2, p 2 to, k 5, p 1, k 10, leave 4.
Fifth row.—Sl 1, k 6, n, o 2, n, n, o 2, n, k 1, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, n, o, k 2.
Sixth row.—K 6, o 2, p 2 to, k 3, p 1, k 3, p 1, k 6, leave 6.
Seventh row.—Sl 1, k 6, p 2 to, n, k 3, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o, n, k 2.
Eighth row.—K 7, o 2, p 2 to, k 5, p 1, k 6, leave 8.
Ninth row.—Sl 1, k 2, n, o 2, n, n, o 2, n, k 1, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, n, o, k 2.
Tenth row.—K 8, o 2, p 2 to, k 3, p 1, k 3, p 1, k 2, leave 10.
Eleventh row.—Sl 1, k 2, n, o 2, n, k 3, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o, n, n, o, k 2.
Twelfth row.—K 9, o 2, p 2 to, k 5, p 1, k 2, leave 12.
Thirteenth row.—Sl 1, k 7, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, n, o, n, o, n, o, k 2.
Fourteenth row.—K 10, o 2, p 2 to, k 6, leave 14.
Fifteenth row.—Sl 1, k 5, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, o, n, o, n, o, n, o, k 2.
Sixteenth row.—K 11, o 2, p 2 to, k 4, leave 16.
Seventeenth row.—Sl 1, k 3, o 2, p 2 to, k 1, o, n, o, n, o, n, o, k 2.
Eighteenth row.—K 12, o 2, p 2 to, k 2, leave 18.
Nineteenth row.—Sl 1, k 1, o 2, p 2 to, k 12.
Twentieth row.—Bind off 9, k 2, o 2, p 2 to, k 20.
Repeat 8 times more.
There should be 5 points on each side and on each corner. Join and sew around center. If very fine thread is used, the joining will not show.

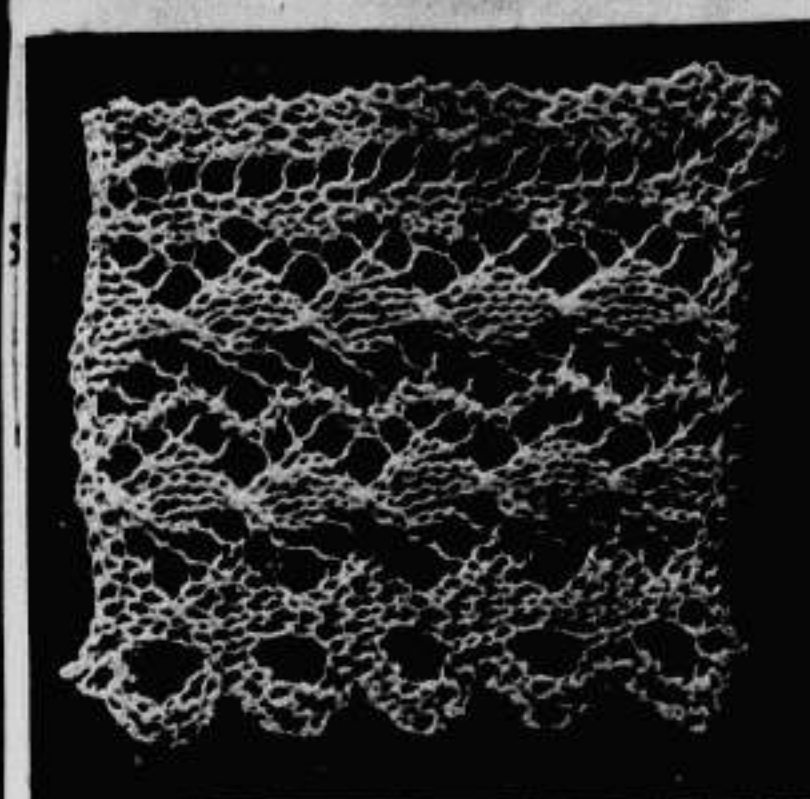


FIGURE No. 2.—EDGING FOR A CHILD'S SKIRT.

EDGING FOR A CHILD'S SKIRT.

FIGURE No. 2.—This knitted edging is particularly desirable for a child's skirt. If employed in making a white skirt of muslin, cambrie or lawn, a cluster of tucks may be placed above the edge and the knitted insertion illustrated at figure No. 3 set in above the tucks. If worked of fine cotton a very dainty lace is produced. The edging may also be worked in Saxony for a flannel skirt.

Cast on 22 stitches and knit across plain.

First row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, k 2, o, n, k 1, n, o, n, o, k 3, o, n, k 4.
Second row.—K 5, p 5, k 2, p 3, k 7.
Third row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, k 3, o, k 3 to, o, n, o, k 5, o, n, k 3.
Fourth row.—K 2, o twice, k 3, p 5, k 2, p 3, k 7.
Fifth row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, k 1, n, o, k 3, o, n, o, n, k 1, n, o, k 3, (k 1, p 1, k 1) in loop, k 2.
Sixth row.—K 9, p 3, k 2, p 5, k 6.
Seventh row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, n, o, k 5, o, n, o, k 3 to, o, k 9.
Eighth row.—Bind off 3, k 5, p 3, k 2, p 5, k 6.
In binding off, slip the first stitch. Repeat from first row.

INSERTION FOR A CHILD'S SKIRT.

FIGURE No. 3.—Cast on 23 stitches and knit across plain.

First row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, k 2, o, n, k 1, n, o, n, o, k 3, o, n, k 1, o, n, k 2.
Second row.—Sl 1, k 5, p 5, k 2, p 3, k 7.
Third row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, k 3, o, k 3 to, o, n, o, k 5, o, n, o, k 2.
Fourth row.—Sl 1, k 5, p 5, k 2, p 3, k 7.
Fifth row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, k 1, n, o, k 3, o, n, o, k 3, o, n, o, n, k 1, n, o, k 2, o, n, k 2.
Sixth row.—Sl 1, k 6, p 3, k 2, p 5, k 6.
Seventh row.—Sl 1, k 1, n, o, n, o, k 5, o, n, o, k 3 to, o, k 3, o, n, k 2.
Eighth row.—Sl 1, k 6, p 3, k 2, p 5, k 6.
Repeat from first row.

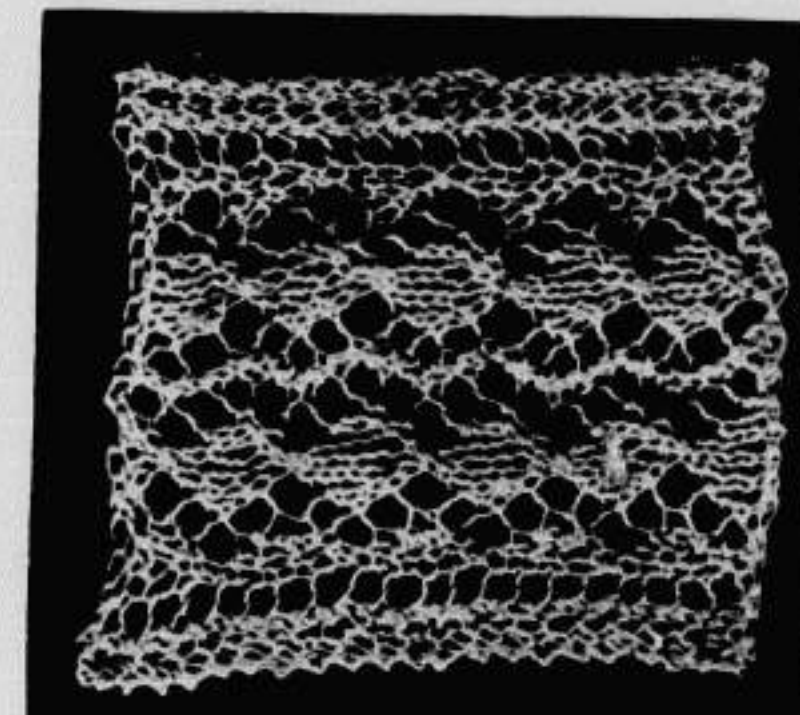


FIGURE No. 3.—INSERTION FOR A CHILD'S SKIRT.
