July 11 Moderate N. winds ship on both tacks and steering N. on one and E.S.E. on the other. Grains were breaching. Shorten sail at night on Larboard tack.

July 12 Fair and S.W. to N winds raise whale at 11 - a.m. coming fast to windward lower boats after dinner but could not get her after getting to windward of her she was going to fast for us to follow kept up to windward all afternoon and all night under full sail and very light winds
