Fair and moderate winds under full sail and full and by on port tack heading S.W. to S.

Moderate S.E. trades well to the S. under full sail and by the wind on port tack

Moderate winds with occasional squall ship under full sail and by the wind on port tack heading S.W.

Fair moderate S.E. trades under full sail heading S.W. by the wind

4-34 S. 29-29 W.

Nov. 9

Fair moderate good wind a little more to the E. ship under full sail and steering S.W.

6-35 S. 29-57 W.

Nov. 10

Fair moderate trades ship under full sail and by the wind heading S.W. See 2 small whales lower boats without success

8-15 S.

Nov. 11

Fair light winds under full sail steering S.W. to S.

10-17 S. 31-28 W.

Nov. 12

Fair and light winds under full sail and steering S.W.

12-08 S.

Nov. 13

Fair light trades 9 am "Carleton Bell" all sail and steering S.W.

13-48 S.

Nov. 14

3-3-58 W.

Fair fresh trades sailing S.W. under full sail.

Nov. 15

Light trades sail W. see schooner at a distance made it to be T. Brown take in sail at night
