Fair moderate S. winds raise whales

This day Fair and moderate N. winds
ship under short sail heading S.W. to S.
on starboard tack. Jam & Alice
knowles with 250 bbls of oil lay night
under fore and main try's. Tacking

Jan. 10

Fair and fresh to light S.W. to N.W. winds
ship under short sail and heading N. to
N. Alice knowles in sight and off and
weather beam lay under try's for
night

47-49 N. 33-45 S.

Jan. 11

This day commenced with moderate N.W. winds
ship on short sail and on starboard tack
finish boiling in early morning. Dump
one tank and stow down 5 ^{2nd} 6th oil
Set all sail at noon and star by the wind
heading N.W. to S.W. star by sail
at night and lay on same tack

48-28 N. 34-14 S.

Jan. 12

This day commenced with a moderate S. wind,
clear. Set all sail in morning and sail
by the wind on port tack heading S.W. to S.
at night take in main and flying jib
and run N.W. with light S.W. winds.

Jan. 13

Fair and light to moderate N.W. to S.W.
winds ship under all sail full and
by on starboard tack at night
were ship shorten sail and lay
under fore & main try's.

Fair and light N. winds calm in afternoon
ship under full sail and star by N.W.
Woodruff in sight
