

Feb. 4

This day commenced with light N.W. winds  
encompassing slow overcast in afternoon  
partly biting and warping on whale  
case pinning cables etc.  
37.15 S. 49.29 W.

Feb. 5

This day moderate N. gales partly  
overcast ship out port fast  
heading E. by S. with trials at noon  
set sails and put ship on starboard  
tack head's N.W. Lat about 37.12 S.

Feb. 6

This day overcast and moderate N.  
gales moderate in afternoon set sails  
put out gear at 2-30 P.M. not able  
to ascertain position

Feb. 7

This day commenced with light S. winds  
and a high swell but the calm put  
ship under bare poles school of  
whales try to wear ship to go for  
them but fair's not wind enough  
to go round and too much of a  
swell to lower boats in afternoon  
see school of black fish. Terribly  
inconfortable with high seas and  
no wind

Fair light winds smooth raise large  
whale at noon lower boats chase all  
afternoon with out success

Fair and light N. winds ship under full  
sail and on N.W. tack see a lot of  
squid and school black fish  
lay under bare poles for the night  
48.40 N. 35.16 S.

Feb. 10

Fair and light N.W. winds set all sail  
in early morning got longitude from  
N. orbegean of Park and find chronometer  
slow 2.36 or 39 miles to the east. In  
all probability N. is correct being a few  
days out of port. Lay under full sail  
B. No. 49.10 W. 35.32 S.

Fair and light N. winds ship under  
full sail full and by on N.E. tack  
see any amount of Grampus  
spray down and lay on same tack  
for the night  
48.21 N. 34.35 S.

Feb. 12

Fair and light winds just from N.  
then S.W. - S. - S.E. see full sail the night  
and clear E. and E. by S. Officer attend  
their respective watches.

Feb. 13

Fair and light E. winds ship  
under full sail and heading N.E.  
full and by 33.17 S. 46.19 W.

Feb. 14

Fair light E. N. E winds ship under full  
sail and by the wind  
31.34 S. 45.22 W.
