Moderate N.E. winds on short sail and N. tack

Feb. 20

This day commenced with squalls moderate N.E. winds and choppy seas ship under main-trysail & fore'sail and flying jib and on starboard tack. nearly calm after noon at night fresh S.W. winds set main'sail on port tack and steer by the wind heading S. by E.

Feb. 21

This day moderate to very light N.E. winds ship on port tack by the wind and heading S. ~~Darken time~~ off lee quarter. Under full sail

light N.E. winds under full sail by the wind and on E. tack lower part for school black fish and got 5

Feb. 23

light to strong N.E. winds ship under full sail and by the wind on E. tack

Fair light N. by S.W. winds under full sail steering S. by E., N.E. by E., N.E. and N.E. by N.

26-30 S. 41-22 N.

Feb. 26

light S.W. to moderate S.E. winds ship under full sail and steering S. by N.

40-09 N. 25-40 S.

Feb. 27

Calm rain. In afternoon clear and light N. winds make all sail & steer to the E. and N.
