9-26 S. 22-42 S.

March 13

Moderate winds well to the S. E. ship under full sail and steering N. N. W. land in sight in morning "atal" overcast and squally in afternoon

Moderate wind squally ship under all sail steering N. N. W. and N. N. E.

Light S. E. wind squally and rain ship under full sail and steering N. N. W. and N. N. E.
