

May 24 This day fair and a light wind from S.E. ship under lower sail and flew by the wind on starboard tack heading E. to S.E.

May 25 This day fair and light S. winds ship by the wind and on starboard tack heading E. at night put ship on N. tack

60-22 V 32-00

May 26 This day fair and light S. winds ship under full sail and by the wind on starboard tack since 7 a.m. heading S.E. and S.E. to S. course

60-17 V 31-50 N.

May 27 Fair and moderate S. winds put ship on N. tack in morning and steered by the wind on port tack heading S.W. raised whales at 12-45 P.M. hauled at 2-30 got 3 by night set boat watches and lay with whales alongside night

60-01 V 31-35 N.

May 28 This day overcast moderate S. winds and light rain squalls put up cutting gear and cut in 3 whales by 8 a.m. Set fore and main ship tacks (main's) and set try of light jibs

59-58 V 31-53 N

May 29 This day fresh S winds ship under short sail and laying on port tack until night then starboard partly overcast finish fishing saw three masted ships beating to windward under lower sails late at noon

31-51 N.

May 30 Partly overcast and fresh S. winds high sea ship under fore and main tacks and all day on starboard tack wind moderating late in afternoon. Rain in morning and tightening to the west night of the 29th to

May 31 This day partly overcast fresh southerly winds and a rough sea ship under short sail and all day on E. tack

58-51 V 31-51 N.

May 32 This day fair and fresh to light S. to S.W. winds ship under main and flying jib by the wind on starboard tack heading S.E. to S.W. and S. late in afternoon

57-18 V 31-21 N.

June 2 This day fair very light S.W. winds make all sail in morning and sail by the wind until noon then set off S.E. raised whales at 5-15 P.M. have out of one set boat watches

30-54 N.
