

Oct. 8th

Leave Fayal harbor at 2 P.M. bound
River Plata moderate to fresh S. winds
under full sail, take in main at 8.30
P.M. Steaming S.S.W. - On 12th slow-
crossing 1.65 p. day

Oct 9th

Moderate gale ship under short
sail and steering S.S.W. wind S. and
gradually veering to S.

Oct 10

Carry away fore
top mast.

Light S.W. winds set all sail in morning
and steered by the wind fresh wind
at 10 A.M. Carry away fore top mast
clear everything without danger
set sail again and steered course wind
lighter calm at night take in
mainsail and set again at 11.30 P.M.

Oct 11

Overcast squally and fresh winds
from S.W. ship under full sail
until night take in mainsail and set
main again till morning
33.16 - 27.00 V.

Oct 12

Whale

Fresh S.W. winds ship under all sail
and by the wind on starboard tack
heading S.E. saw whale at 3 P.M.
lower boats and haul it fluked by
night set boat watches till morning
32.30 N.

Oct 13

Strong S.W. winds put up cutting gear
and cut in whale. light fires

Oct 14

Strong winds S. and W. under short sail
and by the wind

24-22 N 32-19 W

Oct 15

Moderate winds finish furling set all
sail and by the wind heading S.E. & S. on
starboard tack wind S.

Oct 16

Moderate S. winds ship under full
sail full and by on starboard tack
heading S.E. & S.

22-07 N 32-30 W

Oct 17

Moderate S. winds and calm with rain

31.56 N.

Oct 18

S.W. winds rain in abundance ship under
short sail

Oct 19

One continuous shower heavy squalls
N. wind ship under short sail and
running S.W.

30-17

Oct 20

Squally N. winds ship under full sail
and running from S.W. to S.E. wind
light at times hard seas

21-00 N 27-54 W

Oct 21

Overcast moderate N.E. winds ship under
short sail and steering S. S.E. & S.W. & S.E.
sail going S. rough seas
