

Feb. 3

This day foggy in morning clear and fine in afternoon with a swell and light winds Woodruff in sight Lower Boat in afternoon for what we thought was a whale but was in fact a grampus at night calm take in all sail and lay under bare poles

49-33 N. 34-38 S.

Feb. 4

This day clear and fine light southerly winds ship under full sail running E. Woodruff kept off and we approach her had seen grampus were ship at noon and run N.E. Late in afternoon Woodruff lower boats and got whale we beat to the S to get close but were to far take in all sail but fore stay'd and lay the night on Southern tack Woodruff off weather beam

34-15 S 47-59 N.

Feb. 5

This day fine and clear very light winds from S.E. and E. ship under full sail since early morning and on star board tack by the wind heading E. to N.E. any amount of grampus and other species of whale almost any time but a sperm whale A.V.S.W. cutting to the N of us and close aboard in morning shorten sail at night and lay under try'sail for night

47-23-30 N. 33-38 S.

Feb. 6

This day fair freshening winds ship under all sail and by the wind on port then starboard tack 222 any amount of grampus black fish cut up squid and fish run for white water that turned out to be grampus

Feb. 6 This day fair fresh to strong winds ship under short sail all day and on 2 tack wind E.N.E. Woodruff in sight during afternoon shorten down to try'sail at night

33-37 S. 47-22 N.

Feb. 7

Moderate weather overcast choppy seas under short sail and on port and starboard tack consecutively E. to E.N.E. winds

Feb. 8

This day fresh N.E. winds veering to N.W. see whales in early morning and lose sight of them again on account of heavy squalls and rain weather better after squall set all sail and beat to wind all day without success clear in afternoon and calm for nearly 24 hours at night.

Feb. 9

This day fair in morning N. to N.W. wind set all sail and clear by the wind on starboard tack raise whale at 8.30 Am. lower boats at 10 - and there two small flushed by 1 P.M. with cutting gear and cut in whale lay on starboard tack under try'sail trading

Feb. 10

This day light N. winds ship under try'sail all day on account of swell boiling finished at night kee proff N.N.E. and run all night

Feb. 11

This day fair and light S.E. winds run all day N.N.E. under try'sail repairing fore'sail

34-10 S.

Feb. 12

This day foggy light wind in morning and calm in afternoon set all sail and steer N.N.E. and N.E.
