

Nov. 15

This day wind strong from S. - A.M. from E.S.E. ship under all sail and steering N.E. at average 9 knots an hour call men from aloft at 10 - A.M. So ends

- 16 Very strong E.S.E. wind ship under full sail and steering N.E. at 2-30 A.M. took in gaff to pick up mast heads to be in ship till at 1-10 P.M. at 3-10 P.M. wind gradually decreasing rain squalls all through the remainder of the day So ends

- 17 Light E.S.E. winds course N.N.E. Set jib top of at 6 am. fore gaff to pick at 4-40 am. at 11-45 am. change course to N.E. to N. ship sight bearing to the N.E. 3 masted schooner came in sight at 1-45 P.M. going about S.E. to S. So ends

- 18 Moderate E.S.E. winds steamer bore in sight at 3 - am. found S. fore gaff top of take in at midnight wind shifted N.E. to E. ship heading N. 62 m. til 7 - P.M. then came up to course N.N.E. fore and main top set at 9 - P.M. Several steamers So ends

- 19 Moderate easterly winds ship under full sail and steering course N.N.E. land came in sight at 5-20 am. at 4-30 P.M. land bore E.S. distance about 10 ship course changed N.N. to N. take in main and jib top of taking in at 7 - P.M. wind blew fresh for remainder of day So ends

Nov. 16

This day moderate winds from E.S.E. ship under full sail and steering N.N.E. took in jib top of 8-15 am. fore in fore top of main'sle taking in at 10-45 heavy squalls and rain in abundance

- 21 Squally weather E.S.E. winds ship steering N.N.E. Set jib top of and fore top of at 7 - A.M.

- 22 Light variable winds hardly steering way at 9 - am. till more wind at 1 - P.M. wind freshened from E.S. Set main of at 4 - P.M. day ended with very light winds from E.S.

- 23 Very light E.S. winds ship steering N. take in main'sle at 1-30 am. also fore gaff top of flat calm from 10 - am and remained so for the rest of day.

- 24 Calm up to 4 am. when a light air sprang from from the E. Set main'sle at 5-20 am. and steered N. Large school of porpoise day ended with light E.S. wind and rain

- 25 Light winds from E.S.E. ship heading N. bore school of small whales three boats and have 5 feet along side by night

- 26 Light winds from N.E. and E. Cut in whales Set all sail at 11 - am. and steer N.N.E. with moderate winds

- 27 Moderate winds from E.S.E. ship under full sail steering N.N.E. and then N. fresh winds and occasional squalls by end of day
