May 7 Fair and moderate winds ship under full
sail and going along the coast of Honduras
& near rise whales close to St. Kitts lower
2 boats get one bull that sunk after it
was dead make sail again and steer
for St. Estevan came to anchor at
11-30 P.M.

May 8-9:11 Painting took in small amount of
potatoes and sail repairing

May 12 Leave up and leave port at 3-P.M.
bound for West Point a good
N.E. trades and ship under full sail
at night St. Estevan at 25 miles
of at 12 mid night Sontoro light ahead
buff by the wind

May 13 This day fine and with a moderate good
N.E. wind ship under full sail and full
and by heading N. by compass.

May 14 This day fair and light wind from E. ship
under full sail and steering full and
by

May 15 Fair light Easterly wind ship under full
sail and full and by

May 16 This day very light Easterly wind ship under full
sail and steering full and by St. Estevan in
sight in early afternoon going E.W.

25-36 N. 62-52 W.

May 17 This day fair and light Easterly winds
ship under full sail and steering E.N.E.
fair "wanders" off lee beam St. Estevan
and gam in late afternoon
26-30 N.

May 18 Fair and light wind from E. and gradually
veering to S. run N. and later had to
luff some
28-53 N.

May 19 This day partly overcast with light wind
and a sign of rain shortened sail at
night
30-19-39 N.

May 20 Overcast and southerly winds run N. &
under short sail at night luff on account
of swell and lay on starboard tack
rain in abundance
30-31 N.

May 21 Strong S. wind overcast and rain under short
sail and lay on starboard tack at night
wind gave out and took in fore's lay until
morning made main, try's and fore stay's
on starboard tack.

May 22 This day overcast and light southerly winds
in morning set fore's and by night fit
