

June 14 This day overcast and equally then clear with a fresh southerly wind from E. then luff and head S.E. by the wind from E. S.E. with flying fit all day 33-47 N. 50-43

June 15

Nicholson

This day fair with a fresh southerly winds from S. Nicholson with 100 bbls of oil reported, other ships including Tote with 200 from early in May the others with from 50 to a hundred and some with nothing

June 16

Fair and south winds light in morning and later fresh set all sail in morning and sail on the N. tack S. E. S. W. and back in sight shorten sail at night 34-10 N.

June 17

Light Bait

Fair and south winds under all sail on N. N. tack in morning and then on S. E. tack until night shorten sail and lay to the S. E. Back in sight and far to windward 34-32

June 18

This day fair with a southerly wind ship under full sail and running N. N. then N. shorten sail at night 34-16

June 19

This day fair and with a light southerly wind have all sail set and steer N. by E. luff at night 34-18-52-46 N.

June 20 Fair and light winds ship run day N. N. see back off beam going free on other thack large log ~~log~~ sick porpoise 54-09 N. 35-06 N.

June 21

Whale

This day fair with moderate winds from S. E. set all sail in morning and kept N. N. raise whales at 2-00. Got one bull make fast and kept it along side at for night 35-33-55-07

June 22

Whale

This day fair and light winds clear in head and lower boats after a school small whales get 3 Cut in all

June 23

This day continuous rain with fresh to moderate S. E. winds ship under short sail and all day on starboard tack heading E.

June 24

This day overcast with fresh winds from N. and N. N. set all sail in morning for a while had to shorten down on account of squalls ship on both tacks consecutively 55-43 35-49

June 25

Overcast rain and strong S. E. winds ship on N. tack until afternoon and then fire over and lay on S. E. tack 35-56
